RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR TO PREPARE A WRITTEN REPORT TO THE BOARD OUTLINING EFFORTS TO ENFORCE PERMITTING REQUIREMENTS FOR UTILITIES AND PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION IN COUNTY ROAD AND STREET RIGHTS-OF-WAY

WHEREAS, section 2-103.1 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida mandates that anyone constructing utilities or other public works in County road and street rights-of-way must first obtain a permit from the Department of Transportation and Public Works; and

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County Implementing Order 4-41 imposes a penalty fee in the amount of double the original required permit fee on contractors who commence construction work on County right-of-way without first obtaining a legally required permit; and

WHEREAS, construction on County rights-of-way disrupts the busy lives of our residents and visitors by increasing traffic gridlock, reducing access to roadside businesses, and removing the availability of pedestrian sidewalks; and

WHEREAS, because of the disruption caused by public works construction in the rightsof-way, it is imperative to assure that any such construction is safe, permitted and inspected; and

WHEREAS, unpermitted construction work in the rights-of-way is a County-wide problem that does occur and must be deterred to protect the public's safety; and

WHEREAS, this Board wants to ensure that the County is sufficiently using its code enforcement efforts to deter illegal and unpermitted construction work in County rights-of-way,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY

COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated as true and correct.

Section 2. This Board directs the County Mayor to prepare a written report outlining

the County's efforts to enforce the Code requirement that entities constructing utilities or other

public works in County road and streets rights-of-way must first obtain a permit. The report shall

disclose the number of personnel dedicated to enforcing permitting requirements in utilities and

public works construction in County rights-of-way. The report shall disclose the number of

citations and amount of penalty fees collected by the County for unpermitted work in County

rights-of-way during the current fiscal year and two previous fiscal years. The report shall identify

the issues and challenges the County faces in enforcing permitting requirements for utilities and

other public works construction in County rights-of-way. The report shall conclude with

recommendations to improve code enforcement efforts to minimize illegal, unpermitted work on

County rights-of-way.

Section 3. This Board directs the County Mayor to provide this report to this Board

within 60 days of the effective date of this resolution, and to place the completed report on an

agenda of the Board pursuant to Ordinance No. 14-65.
