

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CITY OF MIAMI
CODESIGNATION OF THAT PORTION OF SW 25TH AVENUE
FROM W FLAGLER STREET TO SW 3RD STREET AS
“STINGAREE BOULEVARD”

WHEREAS, Miami Senior High School, located at 2450 SW 1st Street in Miami, Florida, was founded in 1903 and is a historic landmark; and

WHEREAS, Miami Senior High School is the oldest high school in the Miami-Dade County Public School system; and

WHEREAS, Miami Senior High School’s mascot is “Whippy the Stingaree”; and

WHEREAS, in honor of Miami Senior High School’s decades of academic and athletic excellence, on April 25, 2019 the Miami City Commission adopted Resolution No. R-19-0164, which codesignated that portion of SW 25th Avenue from W Flagler Street to SW 3rd Street as “Stingaree Boulevard”, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference; and

WHEREAS, the City of Miami would like the County to install signage indicating this codesignation on County street signs and traffic signal masts arms; and

WHEREAS, this Board would also like to recognize Miami Senior High School by approving the City of Miami’s codesignation of that portion of SW 25th Avenue from W Flagler Street to SW 3rd Street as “Stingaree Boulevard”; and

WHEREAS, SW 25th Avenue from W Flagler Street to SW 3rd Street is a city-maintained road located in the City of Miami; and

WHEREAS, this codesignation is located in County Commission District 5,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Approves the City of Miami codesignation of that portion of SW 25th Avenue from W Flagler Street to SW 3rd Street as “Stingaree Boulevard”.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this Resolution to the Mayor and City Commission of the City of Miami, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Department of Transportation and Public Works, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the City of Miami Police Department and the City of Miami Fire-Rescue Department.

A RESOLUTION OF THE MIAMI CITY COMMISSION CODESIGNATING A PORTION OF SOUTHWEST 25TH AVENUE FROM FLAGLER STREET TO SOUTHWEST 3RD STREET, MIAMI, FLORIDA AS "STINGAREE BOULEVARD," WITH FUNDING FOR THE RELATED SIGNAGE TO BE PROVIDED FROM DISTRICT 1 FUNDS; FURTHER DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO TRANSMIT A COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION TO THE HEREIN DESIGNATED OFFICES.

WHEREAS, Miami Senior High School, located at 2450 Southwest 1st Street, Miami, Florida, was founded in 1903 and is a historic landmark; and

WHEREAS, Miami Senior High School is the oldest high school in the Miami-Dade County Public School system; and

WHEREAS, Miami Senior High School's mascot is "Whippy the Stingaree"; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission wishes to honor Miami Senior High School's decades of academic and athletic excellence in the City of Miami;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The recitals and findings contained in the Preamble to this Resolution are adopted by reference and incorporated as if fully set forth in this Section.

Section 2. The City Commission hereby co-designates a portion of Southwest 25th Avenue, Miami, Florida from Flagler Street to Southwest 3rd Street as "Stingaree Boulevard."

Section 3. Funding for related signage to be paid for from District 1 funds.


Section 4. The City Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this Resolution to the Departments of Police, Fire-Rescue, Solid Waste, the Miami-Dade County Department of Transportation and Public Works, and the United States Postal Service as well as the Florida Department of Transportation, District Six for sign installation within the newly designated roadways.

Section 5. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption and signature of the Mayor.¹

¹ If the Mayor does not sign this Resolution, it shall become effective at the end of ten (10) calendar days from the date it was passed and adopted. If the Mayor vetoes this Resolution, it shall become effective immediately upon override of the veto by the City Commission.
