RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR THE COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO STUDY THE FEASIBILITY OF UTILIZING REBUILDING TOGETHER MIAMI-DADE, INC., A NOT-FOR-PROFIT ORGANIZATION, TO ASSIST ECONOMICALLY DISADVANTAGED HOMEOWNERS IN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY WITH ROOF REPAIR; AND REQUIRING A REPORT

WHEREAS, Rebuilding Together Miami-Dade ("RTMD"), a not-for-profit organization formerly known as Christmas in April, was established in 1992 after Hurricane Andrew devastated parts of Miami-Dade County to help homeowners rebuild homes that were destroyed by the storm; and

WHEREAS, following the storm, the founders of RTMD recognized vulnerable homeowners in Miami-Dade County's ongoing need for assistance; and

WHEREAS, for over 25 years, RTMD has provided critical home repair and modification services free of charge to eligible homeowners, including roof replacement, plumbing and electrical repairs, drywall replacement, and bathroom modifications for persons with disabilities; and

WHEREAS, recipients of RTMD's assistance must meet certain requirements, including: the Miami-Dade County's income limits as published by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development; the property must be an owner-occupied, single family home; and the applicant must have owned and resided in the home for a minimum of two years; and

WHEREAS, in 2018, RTMD made repairs to 60 owner occupied homes, five community spaces, and two affordable rental homes; and

WHEREAS, RTMD's efforts have helped to ease the financial strain of home repair on cost-burdened families, preserve naturally occurring affordable housing, provide for housing security and stability, and ensure the safety and health of residents in our community; and

WHEREAS, the County, through the Miami-Dade Community Action Human Services

Department, has certain home rehabilitation loan and grant programs available to limited-income
residents, but the waitlist for such programs are between two and three years; and

WHEREAS, in addition, over the years, members of this Board have made allocations from their district community-based organization discretionary reserve funds and commission district funds to RTMD to make critical repairs to homes located in their districts; and

WHEREAS, nonetheless, the need for home repair services remains, particularly as it relates to the repair and replacement of roofs that sustained significant damage by Hurricane Irma in September of 2017 and whose leaks can contribute to the growth of mold, as well as to further damage to the properties within the homes; and

WHEREAS, this Board wishes to explore the possibility of partnering with RTMD to further assist eligible homeowners with making necessary repairs to their roofs in order to protect their homes, their health, and this community,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board directs the County Mayor or the County Mayor's designee to study the feasibility of utilizing Rebuilding Together Miami-Dade, Inc., to assist in repairing the roofs of economically disadvantaged homeowners in Miami-Dade County, in equitable amounts per commission district. The County Mayor or the County Mayor's designee shall report back to this Board in 60 days and shall place the completed report on an agenda of the Board no later than 30 days after its completion, in accordance with Ordinance No. 14-65.
