Resolution Approving the Plat of Via Ventura Neighborhood 3

#### Recommendation

The following plat is submitted for consideration by the Board of County Commissioners (Board) for approval. This plat for Via Ventura Neighborhood 3 bounded on the north and east by San Simeon Way, on the south approximately 1,070 feet north of Ives Diary Road, and on the west approximately 1,880 feet east of NE 2 Court.

The Miami-Dade County Plat Committee recommends approval of this plat. The Plat Committee is comprised of representatives from:

- Florida Department of Transportation;
- Florida Department of Health;
- Miami-Dade County School Board; and
- Miami-Dade County Departments of Fire Rescue; Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces; Regulatory and Economic Resources: Transportation and Public Works; and Water and Sewer.

Pursuant to Ordinance No. 16-73, this quasi-judicial matter may be submitted directly for placement on the Board's meeting agenda by the Director of the Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources.

A location sketch is attached to this memorandum as Exhibit A.

Full scale copy of the plat and legal description of the boundaries of the land being subdivided, as well as the plat restrictions contained therein, are on file with the Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources.

#### Scope

This plat is located in Commission District 1, which is represented by Commissioner Barbara J. Jordan.

#### Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

If this plat is approved, the fiscal impact to the County would be approximately \$4,250.00 annually for new roadway construction adjacent to the project and a signalized intersection at NE 215 Street and NE 2 Avenue. These costs would be covered by the Department of Transportation and Public Works' annual General Fund allocation.

#### **Track Record/Monitor**

The Development Services Division of the Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources administers the processing of plats and waivers of plat, and the person responsible for this function is Raul A. Pino, P.L.S.



RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PLAT OF VIA VENTURA NEIGHBORHOOD 3, LOCATED IN SECTION 31, TOWNSHIP 51 SOUTH, RANGE 42 EAST (BOUNDED ON THE NORTH AND EAST BY SAN SIMEON WAY, ON THE SOUTH APPROXIMATELY 1,070 FEET NORTH OF IVES DAIRY ROAD, AND ON THE WEST APPROXIMATELY 1,880 FEET EAST OF NE 2 COURT)

WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference; and
