Recommendation for Approval to Award Transit Buses, 40-Foot Compressed Natural

Gas (CNG), and Authorizing the Use of Charter County Transportation Surtax Funds

for Such Purpose

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approve a competitive contract award, *Contract No. FB-01356, Transit Buses, 40-Foot CNG*, to New Flyer of America, Inc. for the Department of Transportation and Public Works (DTPW). The contract provides for the purchase of 140 low-floor heavy duty 40-foot Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) powered buses with accompanying parts, training and ancillary items. This item will replace 140 buses that have exceeded their recommended life cycle of 12 years or 500,000 miles.

This item is placed for Board review pursuant to Miami-Dade County Code Section 29-124(f). The Board may only consider this item if the Citizens' Independent Transportation Trust (CITT) has forwarded a recommendation to the Board prior to the date scheduled for Board consideration or 45 days have elapsed since the issuance of this recommendation. If CITT has not forwarded a recommendation and 45 days have not elapsed since the issuance of this recommendation, a withdrawal of this item will be requested.

Background

At the December 4, 2018 Board meeting, through Resolution No. R-1262-18, DTPW was directed to replace 40-foot buses in the most expeditious way possible. After an attempt was made to access the Commonwealth of Virginia Contact No. *E194-75548*, which was rejected by the Board on July 10, 2019, an invitation to bid (ITB) was advertised on July 26, 2019. On September 11, 2019, three bids were received, including one "No Bid."

The ITB provided two options for award with a Notice to proceed (NTP) date of November 15, 2019. Bidders were advised, should the actual NTP date be later than November 15, 2019, the delivery date(s) will be changed accordingly. Bidders could bid on either the following options:

- Option 1: Award of 140 buses to the lowest priced Bidder who delivers all buses no later than August 31, 2020, when the total bid price of Option 1 is lower by \$1 million or more when compared to the lowest combined bid prices for Option 2.
- Option 2: Award of 140 buses to the lowest two Bidders (70 buses each Bidder) who deliver all buses no later than June 30, 2020.

This recommendation to award utilizes Option 1, as the bid price offered represents a savings of \$3,377,850 to the County when compared to the total price for Option 2. Further, the buses under this recommendation cost \$532,490.00 per bus, which is significantly less than the cost per bus under the Commonwealth of Virginia Contract No. *E194-75548* (Gillig: \$576,987 and New Flyer: \$578,589). The County is saving between \$6.2 million and \$6.4 million under Option 1 when compared to the Commonwealth of Virginia contract mentioned above.

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The recommended contract offers the following new features to the County:

- 1,000 hours of training with the option to purchase additional training as needed;
- Up to three service representatives on-site at County facilities to perform warranty repairs and supply technical support for a minimum one-year period, beginning from the date of acceptance of the last bus of each lot of buses delivered, as follows: 1 to 50 buses, one technical service representative; 51 to 100 buses, two technical service representatives; and 101 to 140 buses, three technical service representatives;
- A linear heat detection line and an optical flame sensor (heat detector) located just above the AC compressor or adjacent to the AC compressor on each bus; and
- Body materials fabricated to reduce maintenance, extend durability and provide consistency of appearance throughout the service life of the bus. Body frame structure, bulkheads and equipment boxes shall be stainless steel or aluminum.

Scope

The scope of this item is countywide in nature.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

The fiscal impact for the five-year term is \$74,548,600. A portion of this purchase will be funded by Charter County Transportation Surtax funds.

Vendor Recommended for Award

An Invitation to Bid was issued under full and open competition. Three bids were received in response to the solicitation, including one "No Bid."

Pursuant to Resolution No. R-477-18, the lowest bidder is recommended in accordance with the method of award per the solicitation and is non-local.

WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. This Board approves award of Contract No. FB-01356 to New Flyer of America, Inc. for the purchase of 140 low-floor heavy duty 40-foot compressed natural gas buses for the Department of Transportation and Public Works with an amount not to exceed \$74,548,600.00, for a five-year term; and authorizes the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to give notice of this award, issue the appropriate purchase orders to give effect to same and exercise all provisions of the contract pursuant to section 2-8.1 of the Code of Miami-Dade

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County, Florida and Implementing Order 3-38. A copy of the contract document is on file with and available upon request from the Internal Services Department, Strategic Procurement Division.

Section 2. This Board authorizes the use of Charter County Transportation Surtax Funds for this project which was in the original Exhibit 1 of the People's Transportation Plan.
