	RESOLUTION REQUIRING A WRITTEN REPORT
	REGARDING CERTAIN NON-GOVERNMENTAL
	ORGANIZATIONS THAT FUNDRAISE ON BEHALF OF

MIAMI-DADE COUNTY

WHEREAS, under the Home Rule Amendment and Charter (the "Charter"), the Board of County Commissioners (the "Commission") is the legislative and governing body of the County; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor is responsible for the management of all administrative departments and for carrying out policies adopted by the Commission; and

WHEREAS, in conformance with the Charter, all County policy decisions are within the purview of the Commission and the Mayor is responsible for the County's operations in accordance with the policies adopted by the Commission; and

WHEREAS, there are associations, foundations, and non-governmental organizations that fundraise in support of particular County departments ("non-governmental organizations"); and

WHEREAS, this Board recognizes the important role that such organizations play as fundraisers for County departments>>,<<¹[[; and

WHEREAS, because members of non-governmental organizations are not elected officials, such organizations despite their importance as fundraisers, should not be involved in the policy decisions or the operations of the County; and

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The differences between the substitute and the original item are indicated as follows: Words stricken through and/or [[double bracketed]] shall be deleted, words underscored and/or >>double arrowed<< are added.

WHEREAS, this Board desires that the role of those non-governmental organizations that fundraise for the County should be limited only to fundraising and such organizations should be precluded from making County policy decisions or implementing policies of the County,]]

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are approved and incorporated as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2. The County Mayor or the Mayor's designee shall provide a written report stating with specificity which County contracts with non-governmental organizations who fundraise on behalf of Miami-Dade County contain provisions that allow or authorize such non-governmental organizations to participate in any activity beyond fundraising. >> The written report shall identify what activities beyond fundraising are permitted under any such contract. << The written report shall be provided to this Board within 90 days of the effective date of this resolution and shall be placed on an agenda of the Board pursuant to Ordinance No. 14-65.

[Section 3. All non-governmental organizations shall be precluded from making County policy decisions or decisions regarding the operation of the County, except as may be provided for in an existing ordinance or a resolution adopted after the effective date of this resolution. To the extent that this section conflicts with any existing contracts between the County and non-governmental organizations, the Mayor or the Mayor's designee is, to the extent legally permissible, directed to attempt to renegotiate the contracts to conform to this policy. The Mayor or Mayor's designee shall provide quarterly reports to this Board on the status of any such renegotiations.]

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The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Senator Javier D. Souto. It was offered by Commissioner , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
