Recommendation for Approval to Award Contract No. FB-01308, Hydraulic Mobile

Column Lifts, and Authorizing the Use of Charter County Transportation Surtax Funds

for Such Purpose

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approve a competitive contract award, *Contract No. FB-01308*, *Hydraulic Mobile Column Lifts*, for the Department of Transportation and Public Works. There is no current contract for these lifts. The most recent lift purchase for the department was a one-time purchase in 2008.

The contract will provide for the purchase of hydraulic mobile column lifts (Lifts). They are used to safely lift buses off the floor in order to allow technicians access to the underside for repair or maintenance work. Lifts are used as sets of four or six, depending on the size of the transit bus. Each set of lifts will include communication and power cables, delivery, assembly, setup, field-testing, and technical, maintenance, and operational training. The new lifts purchased through this contract will be used to replace existing lifts that are beyond economical repair due to their age. The lifts will be between all four Metrobus garages based on the bus maintenance needs and replace older lifts based on conditions beginning with the oldest and the ones in worst mechanical condition.

An invitation to bid was advertised on September 18, 2019. On November 1, 2019, seven bids were received, in addition to one "No Bid." The recommended bidder is the only local vendor. The solicitation requires the awarded vendor have an authorized service representative in South Florida (Broward, Miami-Dade or Monroe Counties), capable of responding to and performing emergency repairs within two hours of notification of a lift failure.

This item is placed for Board review pursuant to Miami-Dade County Code Section 29-124(f). The Board may only consider this item if the Citizens' Independent Transportation Trust (CITT) has forwarded a recommendation to the Board prior to the date scheduled for Board consideration or 45 days have elapsed since the issuance of this recommendation. If CITT has not forwarded a recommendation and 45 days have not elapsed since the issuance of this recommendation, a withdrawal of this item will be requested.

Scope

The scope of this item is countywide in nature.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

The fiscal impact for the one-year term is \$1,064,037. This purchase will be funded by Charter County Transportation Surtax funds.

If this item is approved, the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee will have the authority to exercise all provisions of the contract, including any cancellation or extension provisions, pursuant to Section 2-8.1 of the County Code and Implementing Order 3-38.

An Invitation to Bid was issued under full and open competition. Seven bids were received in response to the solicitation, including one "No Bid." The responsive and responsible bidder is being recommended for award in accordance with the method of award per the solicitation, as indicated in the table below.

RESOLUTION APPROVING AWARD OF CONTRACT NO. FB-01308 TO JOBBERS EQUIPMENT WAREHOUSE, INC. FOR THE PURCHASE OF HYDRAULIC MOBILE COLUMN LIFTS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC WORKS WITH AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,064,037.00, FOR ONE-YEAR TERM: AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO GIVE NOTICE OF THIS AWARD. WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. This Board approves award of Contract No. FB-01308 to Jobbers Equipment Warehouse, Inc. for the purchase of Hydraulic Mobile Column Lifts for the Department of Transportation and Public Works with an amount not to exceed \$1,064,037.00, for a one-year term; and authorizes the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to give notice of this award, issue the appropriate purchase orders to give effect to same and exercise all provisions of the contract pursuant to Section 2-8.1 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida and Implementing Order 3-38. A copy of the contract document is on file with and available upon request from the Internal Services Department, Strategic Procurement Division.

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Section 2. This Board authorizes the use of Charter County Transportation Surtax Funds for this Project which was added to Exhibit 1 of the People's Transportation Plan on October 9, 2003.
