RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO (1) DISPLAY A COMMEMORATIVE PLAQUE IN HONOR OF ELIJAH SALEEM IN A METROBUS; (2) IDENTIFY AVAILABLE FUNDING SOURCES FROM WITHIN THE FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020 COUNTY BUDGET THAT INDEPENDENTLY OR COMBINED MAY BE UTILIZED TO FUND THE PLACEMENT OF THE COMMEMORATIVE PLAQUE SHOULD SAID IMPLEMENTATION OCCUR WITHIN THE 2019-2020 FISCAL YEAR, OR TO INCLUDE THE PLACEMENT OF THE COMMEMORATIVE PLAQUE IN THE COUNTY MAYOR'S PROPOSED BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021 SUBMITTED TO THIS BOARD FOR APPROVAL; AND (3) PROVIDE A REPORT WITHIN A SPECIFIED TIME

WHEREAS, on February 18, 2019, Elijah Saleem, a Miami-Dade County Metrobus operator, was on his routine route when he noticed a sinking car in a canal in the area of NW 155th Street and 27th Avenue; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Saleem immediately stopped the bus, secured it, and jumped into the canal to provide aide to the people inside the car; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Saleem bravely rescued a baby and two adults from the sinking car; and WHEREAS, Mr. Saleem's acts of heroism should be commended and recognized,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. This Board directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to display a commemorative plaque in honor of Elijah Saleem inside the Metrobus that Mr. Saleem was operating on February 18, 2019 or inside a Metrobus that is assigned to the route that Mr. Saleem was operating on February 18, 2019.

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to identify available funding sources from within the Fiscal Year 2019-2020 County Budget that independently or combined may be utilized to fund the placement of the commemorative plaque identified in Section 1 above should said implementation occur within the 2019-2020 Fiscal Year,

This Board further directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee

The County Mayor or County Mayor's designee shall, within 90 days of the effective date of this resolution, provide to this Board a report describing the steps taken to comply with Sections 1 and 2 above and shall place the completed report on an agenda of the Board pursuant to Ordinance No. 14-65.
