RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. R-899-20 TO DIRECT THE COUNTY MAYOR OR DESIGNEE TO PLACE THE REPORT ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PROPOSED TREE REPLACEMENT PROGRAM ON AN AGENDA OF THE BOARD WITHIN 30 DAYS

**WHEREAS**, trees provide shade and beauty, as well as broader environmental and resiliency benefits, and all of these benefits may preserve and improve the quality of life in Miami-Dade County (the "County"); and

**WHEREAS**, although trees can provide these benefits, choosing the appropriate tree species and appropriate locations of such tree species is of the utmost importance; and

**WHEREAS**, if the wrong tree is placed in the wrong place, that tree placement could result in significant damage to sidewalks, streets, structures, or infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, in addition to the cost of the needed repairs to damage caused by destructive trees, the cost for residents to remove and replace destructive trees can also present a financial burden; and

**WHEREAS**, by contrast, the correct planting of appropriate native trees in the right locations, with adequate maintenance, may create beauty and shade, moderate temperatures, reduce long-term costs, and provide other important environmental and resiliency benefits; and

**WHEREAS**, recognizing the need to implement a program with the goal of replacing destructive or invasive non-native trees with appropriate trees, on August 31, 2020, this Board adopted Resolution No. R-899-20, which directed the administration to create a proposed tree replacement program for the County; and

**WHEREAS**, additionally, Resolution No. R-899-20 directed the County Mayor or designee to prepare a report with detailed information and recommendations on the implementation of the proposed tree replacement program; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Mayor or designee was further directed to place the report on an agenda of the Board pursuant to Ordinance No. 14-65 within 180 days of the effective date of Resolution No. R-899-20; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. R-899-20 was adopted on August 31, 2020 and became effective on September 10, 2020, and therefore, the report is currently required to be placed on an agenda of the Board by March 9, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board wishes to direct the County Mayor or designee to the expedite the preparation of the report so that it may be placed on an agenda of the Board within 30 days of the effective date of this resolution,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board amends section 2 of Resolution No. R-899-20, adopted by this Board on September 3, 2020, to direct the County Mayor or designee to place the report on the implementation of the proposed tree replacement program on an agenda of the Board pursuant to Ordinance No. 14-65 within 30 days of the effective date of this resolution.
