RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO ADVERTISE AND CONDUCT A COMPETITIVE PROCUREMENT FOR TWO ADDITIONAL GENERAL AERONAUTICAL **SERVICE PROVIDERS** TO **PROVIDE SERVICE** AT **MIAMI** TO PLACE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT AND THE RESULTING RECOMMENDATION BEFORE THE BOARD OF **COUNTY COMMISSIONERS** 

WHEREAS, airlines flying into and out of Miami International Airport (MIA) use general aeronautical service providers (GASPs) to load and unload baggage, provide porter services, clean planes, staff checkpoints, and numerous other services; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners has currently authorized five GASPs to provide services at MIA; and

WHEREAS, the County has the right to increase the number of firms providing GASP services at MIA; and

**WHEREAS**, ensuring that the airlines making use of MIA have a broad pool of GASPs to utilize is of critical importance, as high quality GASP services makes MIA more attractive to both airlines and passengers; and

WHEREAS, MIA is the largest economic engine in the County, and ensuring that airlines and passengers continue to look favorably at MIA will help MIA recover and grow as the County emerges from the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, since 2019, approximately 10 airlines have begun service to Miami International Airport, including JetBlue and Southwest, which bring significant volumes of passengers; and

WHEREAS, the existing GASPs at Miami International Airport have exhausted their base

contract term, and the County has exercised the contractual option years on those GASPs; and

WHEREAS, procurement of additional GASPs now will ensure that there is no gap in

services when the existing permits are re-procured; and

WHEREAS, the airline community at MIA supports adding additional GASPs,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY

COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the County Mayor or

County Mayor's designee is directed to advertise and conduct a competitive procurement for two

additional General Aeronautical Service Providers to provide service at Miami International

Airport, to conclude that process within 90 days, and, at the conclusion of that process to place the

award recommendation, or rejection of proposals, before this Board. In the event that this process

cannot be concluded within 90 days, the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee shall file a

notice with the Clerk of the Board indicating the causes of the delay and the estimated time until

the process concludes.
