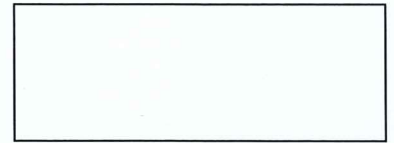

SUBJECT: Resolution Approving the City of Miami's Codesignation of that Portion of Northwest 5th Street between Northwest South River Drive and Northwest 10th Avenue as "Richard Herron Way"

Section 2-1 Rule 9.02(g) of the Code requires the Office of the Commission Auditor (OCA) to conduct background research on any person, organization, place, or thing that is the subject of a naming, renaming, or codesignation item, or an item approving the codesignation of state or municipal roads and prepare a report detailing the findings of said research prior to the Commission meeting during which the item is scheduled to be considered.

Commission Auditor's Conclusion:

OCA completed the required background research on "Richard Herron" and noted no adverse findings. OCA has determined that there are no prior Board of County Commissioners (BCC) codesignations for the "Richard Herron." Also, as required by rule 9.02(g)(1), OCA has verified that "Richard Herron" is deceased. OCA provides this report as a Supplement to BCC Agenda File Item No. 252209.
