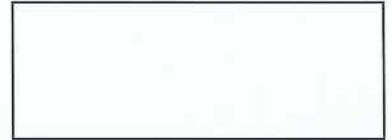

**SUBJECT:** Resolution codesignating that portion of Northwest 65<sup>th</sup> Avenue between Northwest 7<sup>th</sup> Street and Waterford District Drive as "Carnival Place"

Section 2-1 Rule 9.02(g) of the Code requires the Office of the Commission Auditor (OCA) to conduct background research on any person, organization, place, or thing that is the subject of a naming, renaming, or codesignation item, or an item approving the codesignation of state or municipal roads and prepare a report detailing the findings of said research prior to the Commission meeting during which the item is scheduled to be considered.

**Commission Auditor's Conclusion:**

OCA completed the required background research on "Carnival Corporation" and noted the following:

***Carnival Corporation,***

- *Carnival Corporation, a publicly traded company, has disclosed in its Audited Financial Statements that it is currently subject to legal proceedings and government investigations in the normal course of business. The OCA was able to corroborate the statement by observing the various litigations reported through legal research.*

OCA has determined that there are no prior Board of County Commissioners (BCC) codesignations for the "Carnival Corporation." OCA provides this report as a Supplement to BCC Agenda File Item No. 252444.
