Subject: Resolution Amending Resolution R-800-24, Revising the Award Amount from \$807,975.00 to \$857,600.00 and Match from \$907,225.00 to \$902,452.49 for the Crandon Park Marina North and South Seawalls Replacement Project

Executive Summary

The purpose of this item is to gain authorization from the Board of County Commissioners (Board) to amend Resolution R-800-24, which approved Miami-Dade County Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces (PROS) Department's award amount of \$807,975.00 for the Crandon Park Marina North and South Seawalls Replacement project. This resolution amendment corrects scrivener's errors in resolution R-800-24, correcting the grant award amount from \$807,975.00 to \$857,600.00, and project match from \$907,225.00 to \$902,452.49.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board amend resolution R-800-24, to authorize a correction of \$807,975.00 to \$857,600.00 in grant award funding and project match from \$907,225.00 to \$902,452.49 for the Crandon Park Marina North and South Seawalls Replacement project from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection's (FDEP) Resilient Florida Program.

Scope

Crandon Park Marina is located within County Commission District 7, which is represented by Commissioner Raquel A. Regalado.

Delegation of Authority

The Board authorizes the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to receive and expend all monies for the purposes described in the funding request for and on behalf of Miami-Dade County, Florida.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

- This project supports the construction of the Crandon Park Marina North and South Seawalls Replacement project from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) Resilient Florida Program.
- On August 20, 2024, PROS was granted an award of \$857,600.00. On September 17, 2024, The Board retroactively approved the submission of the FDEP Resilient Florida Program grant application requesting \$857,600.00. However, resolution R-800-24 approved by the Board lists \$807,975.00 in award funding and \$907,225.00 in match funding. The actual amount awarded on the resolution should read as \$857,600.00 in awarded funds and \$902,452.49 in match funding. The grant award and match values approved in R-800-24 are scrivener's errors.

- The County's estimated total project cost is \$1,760,207.00 for the construction of the Crandon Park Marina North and South Seawalls Replacement project. FDEP will provide funds of up to \$857,600.00 representing 49% of total project cost. The County will provide \$902,452.49 in match dollars from the Capital Infrastructure Improvement Program, representing 51% of total project cost. This match amount includes contractual services and costs ineligible for FDEP funding such as salary and fringe benefits. The County match provides sufficient funding to complete the project.
- This project is a prioritized project in the Miami-Dade County 2025-2026 Approved Budget Book.

Track Record/Monitor

This grant will be administered by PROS' Grants Supervisor, Dorothy Mills-Mayers.

Background

FDEP's Resilient Florida program was established by Florida State Legislature in 2021 within Florida Senate Bill 1954. This enhances Florida state's efforts to protect inland waterways, coastlines and shores, which serve as invaluable natural defenses against sea level rise. Resilient Florida Program grants are available to counties, municipalities, special districts with specific responsibilities and regional resilience entities. Eligible projects include vulnerability analysis and planning studies, as well as implementation projects for adaptation and mitigation.

On August 20, 2024, PROS was granted an award of \$857,600.00. On September 17, 2024, the Board retroactively approved the submission of the FDEP Resilient Florida Program grant application requesting \$857,600.00. However, resolution R-800-24 approved by the Board lists \$807,975.00 in award funding and \$907,225.00 in match funding. The actual amount awarded on the resolution should read as \$857,600.00 in awarded funds and \$902,452.49 in match funding. The grant award and match values approved in R-800-24 are scrivener's errors.

Due to the scrivener's errors, it is necessary to amend the Crandon Park Marina North and South Seawalls Replacement project's award amount from \$807,975.00 to \$857,600.00 and project match from \$907,225.00 to \$902,452.49. This project is a prioritized project in the Miami-Dade County 2025-2026 Adopted Budget Book.

RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board amends Resolution No. R-800-24 to authorize a revision of \$807,975.00 to \$857,600.00 in awarded grant funding from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection Resilient Florida Program, to be used for the construction of the Crandon Park Marina North and South Seawalls Replacement Project, and authorizes a revision of \$907,225.00 to \$902,452.49 in funds used for construction from the Capital Infrastructure Improvement Plan for the Crandon Park Marina North and South Seawalls Replacement Project, and further authorizes the County Mayor or County Mayor's

designee to accept and expend funds and execute contracts, amendments, and other documents as required by the agreement, upon review and final approval of the County Attorney’s Office for legal sufficiency.


