**RESOLUTION RENAMING THE MIAMI-DADE POLICE
DEPARTMENT HEADQUARTERS THE "FRED TAYLOR
MIAMI-DADE POLICE DEPARTMENT HEADQUARTERS"**

WHEREAS, Fred Taylor was the Director of the Miami-Dade Police Department from November 1986 through March 1997; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Taylor is an outstanding individual who has given tirelessly to Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County owns and operates the Miami-Dade Police Department Headquarters; and

WHEREAS, this Board desires to honor Mr. Taylor by renaming the Miami-Dade Police Department Headquarters the "Fred Taylor Miami-Dade Police Department Headquarters,"

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. This Board finds that Fred Taylor has made a direct, significant lifetime contribution to this community.

Section 2. By three-fifths vote of the Board members present, this Board renames the Miami-Dade Police Department Headquarters the "Fred Taylor Miami-Dade Police Department Headquarters."

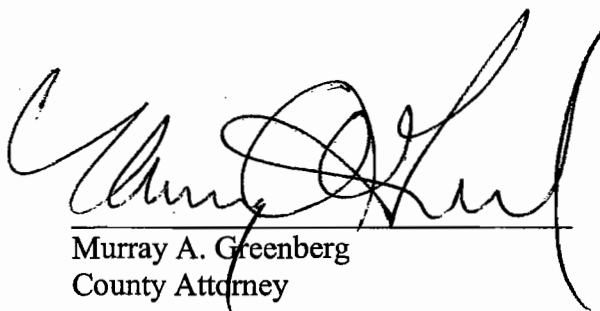
