WHEREAS, Miami Carol City Senior High has requested in-kind services from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department for the October 19, 2006 Rally for Peace and Prosperity in an amount not to exceed \$716.00 (see attached Fee Waiver/In-Kind Service Application); and

WHEREAS, the Rally for Peace and Prosperity is a small event, as that term is defined in the attached Fee Waiver/In-Kind Service Application, and the in-kind services shall be funded from the District 1 In-kind Reserve Fund,

Subject: District Specific In-Kind Reserve Request Recommendation

The Office of Strategic Business Management (OSBM) has reviewed the attached in-kind request and recommends for the item to move forward to the Board of County Commissioners for consideration. The district specific in-kind reserve balance allows for the funding of this request.

Background

Miami Carol City Senior High is requesting a retroactive waiver for in-kind services for their Peace and Prosperity Rally held on October 19, 2006.
