

RECOMMENDATION

The attached **Project Award Recommendation** for a Resurfacing Contract (Project – CICC 7360-0/08 RPQ No. 20060328), in the amount of \$1,151,000.00, between H & J Asphalt, Inc. and Miami-Dade County has been prepared by the Public Works Department (PWD) and is recommended for approval. One (1) site has been identified for this contract and is listed as follows: North 46 Street, from NE 2 Avenue to NW 37 Avenue. Additional sites may be added during the term of this contract. Proceeds from the Charter County Transit System Sales Surtax (the Surtax) will be used to fund this project, therefore, approval by the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) and Citizens' Independent Transportation Trust (CITT) is required.

BACKGROUND

In an effort to accelerate the continued success of the People's Transportation Plan (PTP) Neighborhood Improvements initiative, PWD is taking advantage of various contracting mechanisms, such as the subject Miscellaneous Construction Contracting (MCC) process available through the Office of Capital Improvements (OCI) contract CICC 7360-0/08. Through this process, PWD forwards the Request for Price Quotation (RPQ), by way of facsimile transmission and US-mail, to a pool of firms that are registered with OCI for the subject trade. Additionally, PWD advertises the project in the Daily Business Review as well as providing courtesy notifications in the Diario De Las Americas, Miami Herald, Miami Times, Haiti en Marche, Le Floridien, and Kiskeya Herald.

For this contract, interested contractors prepare their bids according to the Job Order Contracting (JOC) process, whereby the County establishes unit prices for the pay items in accordance with industry averages. The contractors submit their bid as an overall percentage factor of the pricing established by the County. The project award evaluation is based upon the lowest percentage submitted by the responsive, responsible bidder for the project. PWD staff submitted the referenced project to the Department of Business Development's (DBD) Review Committee on October 4, 2006. The Review Committee reviewed and recommended no contract measures for RPQ 20060328.

Therefore, on October 17, 2006, PWD issued an RPQ for a Resurfacing Contract and forwarded it to a list of 58 pre-registered firms from the OCI database as noted above. Six (6) firms purchased contract documents and four (4) firms proffered a bid. As a result, on November 21, 2006, PWD issued a recommendation of award for RPQ 20060328 with a percentage factor of 1.16 to H & J Asphalt, Inc. with the stipulation that approval of this project must be obtained from the BCC and the CITT due to guidelines associated with the funding source.

The work to be accomplished for this project consists of, but is not limited to, clearing and excavating of shoulder areas or build-up, grading and clean-up of adjacent shoulders and removal of roots, if required. Additional work to be performed includes milling of existing pavement, resurfacing of the full roadway, the widening and resurfacing of intersecting streets, resurfacing of asphalt pathways (pedestrian, bicycle, etc.) adjacent or not to edge of pavement, if necessary.

The work to be performed under the term of this contract includes resurfacing at various locations throughout Miami-Dade County. One (1) site has been identified for this contract and is listed as follows: North 46 Street, from NE 2 Avenue to NW 37 Avenue. Additional sites may be added during the term of this contract. The base contract amount is \$1,000,000.00, but the total allocated amount is \$1,151,000.00, which is inclusive of the contingency and dedicated allowances.

CONTRACTOR PERFORMANCE

The contractor, H & J Asphalt, Inc., is currently performing work for PWD at a satisfactory level as reported by the Project Manager. PWD has reviewed the OCI database and found 18 awarded contracts for H & J Asphalt, Inc.: 17 from PWD and one (1) from the Department of Environmental Resources Management (DERM). The referenced database also lists a total of 17 contractor performance evaluations: 16 from PWD and one (1) from DERM, all with satisfactory ratings.

Following PWD's standard operating procedures, after award of this contract, a pre-construction meeting will be scheduled. Throughout all PTP projects, the responsible staff person in PWD will continue to be the PTP Coordinator, Mr. David Tinder, P.E. Following completion of the award process, the project will be assigned to Mr. Joaquin Rabassa, P.E., Construction Coordinator, for day to day responsibilities.

According to the Florida Department of State, Division of Corporations, H & J Asphalt, Inc., Company Principals are: Humberto Lorenzo and Jorge Lorenzo and the Company's address is listed as: 4310 NW 35th Avenue, Miami, Florida 33142-4323.

FISCAL IMPACT

The fiscal impact will be approximately \$1,151,000.00 and will be funded from the Surtax. The proposed improvements qualify under the allowable work categories included in the PTP Neighborhood Improvements Section. Specific funding for each project will be allocated from the respective Commission District PTP yearly allocations.



Further, it shall be understood that since proceeds from the Charter County Transit System Sales Surtax levied pursuant to Section 29.121 of the Code of Miami-Dade County may be used to pay for all or some part of the cost of this contract, no award of this contract shall be effective and thereby give rise to a contractual relationship with the County unless and until the following have occurred: 1) the County Commission awards the contract, and such award becomes final (either by expiration of 10 days after such award without veto by the Mayor, or by Commission override of a veto); and 2) either i) the Citizens' Independent Transportation Trust (CITT) has approved same, or ii) in response to the CITT's disapproval, the County Commission re-affirms its award by two-thirds (2/3) vote of the Commission's membership and such reaffirmation becomes final.






