RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE BY MIAMI-DADE COUNTY OF CANAL RIGHT-OF-WAY AND CANAL FLOW RIGHTS DEDICATION IN EXCHANGE FOR THE RELEASE AND QUIT CLAIM OF AN EXCESS COUNTY CANAL RESERVATION, A CANAL RIGHT-OF-WAY, AND A CANAL MAINTENANCE EASEMENT NO LONGER NEEDED IN SECTIONS 25/26/35/36, TOWNSHIP 53 SOUTH, RANGE 39 EAST

WHEREAS this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board approves the acceptance by Miami-Dade County of a canal right-of-way and a canal flow rights dedication by Beacon Lakes Community Development District and by Florida Rock Properties, Inc., in exchange for the release and quit claim of an excess County canal reservation, a canal right-of-way, and a canal maintenance easement which are no longer needed for canal purposes, in Sections 25/26/35/36, Township 53 South, Range 39 East; and authorizes execution of County Disclaimers, and other Deeds by the Mayor in substantially the form attached hereto and made a part hereof, and their recording into the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board approve the attached Resolution authorizing the acceptance by Miami-Dade County of canal right-of-way deeds and a canal flow rights easement dedication in exchange for the release and quit claim of excess canal reservation, a canal right-of-way, and a canal maintenance easement which are no longer needed by the County. This exchange is required as part of the Environmental Quality Control Board (EQCB) Order for the developers of Beacon Lakes and Pan American West (formerly Shoppylane) for the construction of a canal and canal control structure to maintain a hydrologic divide between these developments and the Northwest Wellfield.

BACKGROUND

Miami-Dade County currently holds, by virtue of the following deeds, recorded respectively in Official Records Book (ORB) 2274 at Page 533, ORB 5591 at Page 48, ORB 9067 at Page 1760, ORB 12858 at Page 1378, and ORB 5591 at Page 28 of the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida, certain canal interests described as a canal reservation, a canal right-of-way and a canal maintenance easement. Said canal interests were obtained at no cost to Miami-Dade County as a result of the implementation of the Miami-Dade County Water Control Master Plan. These canal interests are located along the centerline of theoretical NW 25 Street and were acquired for the construction of the NW 25 Street Canal (North Line Canal) between NW 117 Avenue and NW 137 Avenue, in Sections 25/26/35/36, Township 53 South, Range 39 East. The proposed North Line Canal is located south of the Northwest Wellfield and, as constructed, is designed to create a hydrologic divide between the newly developed industrial sites to the south of NW 25 Street and the protected area of the Northwest Wellfield.

The Beacon Lakes Community Development District, together with Florida Rock Properties, Inc. land owners north of said NW 25 Street, have submitted valid deeds to Miami-Dade County for the North Line Canal (NW 25th Street Canal) and are requesting, in exchange, the release of an excess county canal reservation, a right-of-way, and a maintenance easement that are no longer needed for canal purposes. The Department of Environmental Resources Management together with the Public Works Department has reviewed this proposed exchange and recommends its approval.





DETAIL SKETCH W.C. - 819
