RECOMMENDATION

The attached **Project Award Recommendation** for the Traffic Signal Installation at S.W. 137 Avenue and S.W. 156 Street in Commission District 9 (Project – CICC 7360-0/08 RPQ No. 20060315), in the amount of \$212,095.18, between All Quality Electrical Services, Inc. and Miami-Dade County has been prepared by the Public Works Department (PWD) and is recommended for approval. Proceeds from the Charter County Transit System Sales Surtax (the Surtax) will be used to fund this project, therefore, approval by the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) and Citizens' Independent Transportation Trust (CITT) is required.

BACKGROUND

In an effort to accelerate the continued success of the People's Transportation Plan (PTP) Neighborhood Improvements initiative, PWD is taking advantage of various contracting mechanisms, such as the subject Miscellaneous Construction Contracting (MCC) process available under the Office of Capital Improvements (OCI) contract CICC 7360-0/08. Through this process, PWD forwards the Request for Price Quotation (RPQ), by way of facsimile transmission and US-mail, to a pool of firms that have registered with OCI for the subject trade. Additionally, PWD advertises the project in the Daily Business Review as well as providing courtesy notifications in the Diario De Las Americas, Miami Herald, Miami Times, Haiti en Marche, Le Floridien, and Kiskeya Herald. The project award evaluation is based upon the lowest sum bid submitted by the responsive, responsible bidder for the project.

PWD staff submitted the referenced project to the Department of Business Development's (DBD) Review Committee on October 11, 2006. The Review Committee reviewed and recommended no contract measures for RPQ 20060315. Therefore, on October 13, 2006, PWD issued an RPQ for a Traffic Signal Installation Contract and forwarded it to a list of 11 pre-registered firms from the OCI database as noted above. Five (5) firms purchased contract documents and two (2) firms proffered a bid. However, Magesco, Inc. bid was declared non-responsive because they failed to submit a Bid Bond with their bid submittal package. As a result, on December 6, 2006, PWD issued a recommendation of award for RPQ 20060315 to All Quality Electrical Services, Inc. with the stipulation that approval of this project must be obtained from the BCC and the CITT due to guidelines associated with the funding source.

The work to be accomplished for this project consists of, but is not limited to, furnishing all supervision, labor, required materials, and equipment and tools to perform traffic signal installation(s) including any removal of existing pavement, and resurfacing as indicated on the plans, at the intersection of S.W. 137 Avenue and S.W. 156 Street.

The contractor shall furnish and install grounding electrodes, conduits, pull boxes, foundations, pedestrian signal heads and buttons with signs, overhead signs (internally illuminated LED signs), mounting hardware, signal cable, power cable and power services. Additional work to be performed includes expansion of the road adjacent to the intersection as shown on the plans, construct a new median, installing four (4) vehicle detection loops and traffic signal poles, signage and pavement markings. The base contract amount is \$183,897.44, but the total allocated amount is \$212,095.18, which is inclusive of the contingency and dedicated allowances.

CONTRACTOR PERFORMANCE


The OCI database lists four (4) awarded contracts for All Quality Electrical Services, Inc. However, since the contractor is new to the Department, there are no listed contractor performance evaluations on file, since the contracts are still under construction or in the preliminary stages. However, contractor is currently performing work for PWD at a satisfactory level as reported by the Project Manager.

Following PWD's standard operating procedures, after award of this contract, a pre-construction meeting will be scheduled. Throughout all PTP projects, the responsible staff person in PWD will continue to be the PTP Coordinator, Mr. David Tinder, P.E. Following completion of the award process, the project will be assigned to Mr. Oscar Rubio, P.E., Project Manager, for day to day responsibilities.



FISCAL IMPACT

The fiscal impact will be approximately \$212,095.18 and will be funded from the Surtax. The proposed improvements qualify under the allowable work categories included in the PTP Neighborhood Improvements Section. Specific funding for this project will be allocated from the Commission District 9 PTP yearly allocations.






