RESOLUTION NO. R-280-07

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MANAGER TO  
REPORT TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS  
ON THE STATUS OF HIV/AIDS TESTING, TREATMENT  
AND FOLLOW-UP CARE FOR THE JAIL'S INMATE  
POPULATION

**WHEREAS**, Miami-Dade County is a majority-minority community and the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services' Centers for Disease Control and Prevention ("CDC") has determined that "populations of minority races and ethnicities are disproportionately affected by the HIV epidemic" and constitutes "a health crisis for African Americans; and

**WHEREAS**, HIV/AIDS is the number 1 cause of death for African American women aged 25-34 and among the top 3 causes of death for African American men aged 25-54, and

**WHEREAS**, African Americans comprise a significant proportion of the inmate population in the County's Jail; and

**WHEREAS**, the Centers for Disease Control estimates that the rate of HIV/AIDS in correctional facilities is three to five times higher than in the general population; and

**WHEREAS**, the inmate population of the County's Jail is highly transitional with an average length of stay of approximately 23 days; and

**WHEREAS**, the Jail processes approximately 110,000 persons annually; and

**WHEREAS**, testing, treatment and follow-up care for HIV positive inmates is a critical public health concern for the entire community inasmuch as the overwhelming majority of jail

inmates return to the Miami-Dade County community and are otherwise an integral part of our community,


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA,** that the County Manager is directed to submit a report to the Board within thirty (30) days on the status of HIV/AIDS in the County's Jail, which shall document the resources dedicated to this problem, including a breakdown of all funding sources (eg., State and Federal grants), report on jail testing protocols, in-jail treatment services and pre-release planning for follow-up treatment in community based programs and other transitional services for those inmates who test positive.

The foregoing resolution was sponsored by Commissioner Dennis C. Moss and offered by Commissioner Rebeca Sosa, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Dennis C. Moss and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:


