RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE MIAMI-DADE PARK AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT FOR THE FEBRUARY 17, 2007 MARDI GRAS ON KROME EVENT SPONSORED BY HOMESTEAD MAIN STREET, A NOT-FOR-PROFIT ORGANIZATION, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,866.00 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE DISTRICT 9 IN-KIND RESERVE FUND

WHEREAS, Homestead Main Street has requested in-kind services from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department for the February 17, 2007 Mardi Gras on Krome event in an amount not to exceed \$2,866.00 (see attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application); and

WHEREAS, Homestead Main Street is a non-for-profit organization; and

WHEREAS, the Mardi Gras on Krome is a special event, as defined in the attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application, with the purpose of raising funds for the Habitat for Humanity's Musicians' Village in New Orleans that will consist of 81 homes for displaced musicians; and

WHEREAS, the in-kind services shall be funded from the District 9 In-kind Reserve Fund,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board retroactively authorizes in-kind services from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department for the February 17, 2007 Mardi Gras on Krome event in an amount not to exceed \$2,866.00 to be funded from the District 9 In-kind Reserve Fund.



Homestead Main Street plans Mardi Gras on Krome

Homestead Main Street is planting its' first-ever, *Mardi Gras on Krome*, for Sat., Feb. 17, 2007, on Krome Avenue in downtown Homestead. This event will consist of a parade starting at 6 p.m. followed by live musical entertainment featuring the theme, "Put a Y'at back in Nawlins."

The event will be a great celebration. Headlining the musical portion of the evening will be New Orleans legend, **Chewy Thunderfoot Black**. Mr. Black plays Rhythm & Blues music with a true New Orleans flavor and promises to bring a great performance downtown.

Planned not only as a community celebration, Homestead Main Street will use this event as a fundraiser for **Habitat for Humanity's Musicians' Village in New Orleans**. This Habitat for Humanity project was conceived by New Orleans musicians **Branford Marsalis** and **Harry Connick Jr.** The Village will consist of 81 homes for displaced musicians and the **Ellis Marsalis Center for Music**.

The idea for *Mardi Gras on Krome* and supporting Habitat for Humanity's project came from one of Homestead's newest residents and business owners, **Collin Tyler**, who himself is a Katrina evacuee who was forced to relocate with his family following the hurricane. Through his efforts, a group of volunteers were formed, who share his desire to help preserve the culture and flavor of New Orleans.

"In Homestead, we know how it feels to deal with the desperation and hopelessness that follows a devastating hurricane, and Collin brought his New Orleans experiences to us," said **Yvonne Knowles**, Homestead Main Street's executive director. "We hope that by hosting this exciting celebration, we not only bring our community together, but benefit another."
