**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE DESIGNATION OF S.W. 1st
STREET FROM 8th AVENUE TO 12th AVENUE AS "CARLOS
C. LOPEZ-AGUIAR WAY"**

WHEREAS, during the 2006 State Legislative Session, the Florida Legislature passed HB 121, which included a number of state road designations, including designating S.W. 1st Street from 8th Avenue to 12th Avenue as "Carlos C. Lopez-Aguiar Way"; and

WHEREAS, section 334.071, Florida Statutes, provides that the erection of markers by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) on state roads shall be contingent on the appropriate city or county commission passing a resolution in support of the particular honorary road designation; and

WHEREAS, the designation of S.W. 1st Street from 8th Avenue to 12th Avenue as "Carlos C. Lopez-Aguiar Way" is located in the City of Miami and the City previously has approved this road designation on October 12, 2006 by Resolution No. 06-01707; and

WHEREAS, this Board also supports the designation of S.W. 1st Street from 8th Avenue to 12th Avenue in this manner,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board approves the designation of S.W. 1st Street from 8th Avenue to 12th Avenue as "Carlos C. Lopez-Aguiar Way" and approves FDOT placing suitable markers on this state road located within Miami-Dade County.

The foregoing resolution was sponsored by Chairman Bruno A. Barreiro and offered by Commissioner Carlos A. Gimenez, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Dennis C. Moss and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

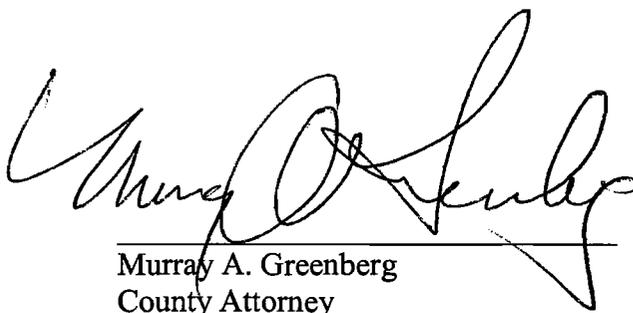
