RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE MIAMI-DADE PARK AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT AND THE MIAMI-DADE POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR THE JANUARY 28, 2007 THIRD ANNUAL WILLIS MCGAHEE FLAG FOOTBALL TOURNAMENT SPONSORED BY THE GWEN CHERRY PARK FOUNDATION, A NOT-FOR-PROFIT ORGANIZATION, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$18,198.00 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE COUNTYWIDE IN-KIND RESERVE FUND

WHEREAS, the Gwen Cherry Park Foundation has requested in-kind services from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department and the Miami-Dade Police Department for the January 28, 2007 Third Annual Willis McGahee Flag Football Tournament in an amount not to exceed \$18,198.00 (see attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application); and

WHEREAS, the Gwen Cherry Park Foundation is a not-for-profit organization; and

WHEREAS, the Third Annual Willis McGahee Flag Football Tournament is a major event, as that term is defined on the attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application, and the in-kind services shall be funded from the Countywide In-kind Reserve Fund,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board retroactively authorizes in-kind services from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department and the Miami-Dade Police Department for the January 28, 2007 Third Annual Willis McGahee Flag Football Tournament in an amount not to exceed \$18,198.00 to be funded from the Countywide In-kind Reserve Fund.





Subject: Countywide In-Kind Reserve Request Recommendation

The Office of Strategic Business Management (OSBM) has reviewed the attached in-kind request and recommends for the item to move forward to the Board of County Commissioners for consideration. The countywide in-kind reserve balance allows for the funding of this request.

Background

A retroactive waiver for in-kind services has been requested by a not-for-profit organization Gwen Cherry Park Foundation for their Third Annual Willis McGahee Flag Football Tournament held on January 28, 2007.

In-kind services have been requested in an amount not to exceed \$14,489.47 from the Miami-Dade Police Department for police services and \$4,198 from the Park and Recreation Department for bleachers; a total in-kind amount of \$18,687.47. This event will be funded from the countywide in-kind reserve fund.

As part of the FY 2006-07 Adopted Budget, the Gwen Cherry Park Foundation received an award in the amount of \$8,180 through the Park and Recreation Department.
