RESOLUTION APPROVING A PROJECT AWARD RECOMMENDATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$163,691.46 BETWEEN RAYDAN ELECTRIC, INC. AND MIAMI-DADE COUNTY FOR THE PEOPLE'S TRANSPORTATION PLAN (PTP) PROJECT ENTITLED TRAFFIC SIGNAL INSTALLATION AT HIALEAH GARDENS BOULEVARD AND WEST 80 STREET IN COMMISSION DISTRICT 12 (PROJECT - CICC 7360-0/08 RPQ NO. 20060358)



Subject: Project Award Recommendation in the Amount of \$163,691.46 Between Raydan Electric, Inc. and Miami-Dade County for the People's Transportation Plan (PTP) Project Entitled Traffic Signal Installation at Hialeah Gardens Boulevard and West 80 Street in Commission District 12 (Project – CICC 7360-0/08 RPQ No. 20060358)

Recommendation

The attached **Project Award Recommendation** for the Traffic Signal Installation at Hialeah Gardens Boulevard (NW 92 Avenue) and West 80 Street (NW 134 Street) within Commission District 12 (Project – CICC 7360-0/08 RPQ No. 20060358), in the amount of \$163,691.46, between Raydan Electric, Inc. and Miami-Dade County has been prepared by the Public Works Department (PWD) and is recommended for approval. Proceeds from the Charter County Transit System Sales Surtax (the Surtax) will be used to fund this project, therefore, approval by the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) and Citizens' Independent Transportation Trust (CITT) is required.

Scope

The signal installation under this subject contract falls solely within the boundaries of Commission District 12.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

The fiscal impact will be approximately \$163,691.46 and will be funded from the Surtax. The proposed improvements qualify under the allowable work categories included in the PTP Neighborhood Improvements Section. Specific funding for this project will be allocated from the Commission District 12 PTP yearly allocations.

Track Record/Monitor

The contractor, Raydan Electric, Inc., is currently performing work for PWD at an above satisfactory level as reported by the Project Manager. PWD has reviewed the OCI database and found 11 awarded contracts for Raydan Electric, Inc., with PWD. The referenced database also lists a total of four (4) contractor performance evaluations, all with above satisfactory ratings. The remaining contracts are still under construction or in the preliminary stages and do not yet have evaluations on file.

Following PWD's standard operating procedures, after award of this contract, a pre-construction meeting will be scheduled. Throughout all PTP projects, the responsible staff person in PWD will continue to be the PTP Coordinator, Mr. David Tinder, P.E. Following completion of the award process, the project will be assigned to Mr. Oscar Rubio, Project Manager, for day to day responsibilities.

According to the Florida Department of State, Division of Corporations, Raydan Electric, Inc., Company Principals are: Ramon Reyes, Helen Reyes and Lazaro L. Hernandez and the Company's address is listed as: 4100 SW 94th Avenue, Miami, Florida 33165.

Background

In an effort to accelerate the continued success of the People's Transportation Plan (PTP) Neighborhood Improvements initiative, PWD is taking advantage of various contracting mechanisms, such as the subject Miscellaneous Construction Contracting (MCC) process available under the Office of Capital Improvements (OCI) contract CICC 7360-0/08. Through this process, PWD forwards the Request for Price Quotation (RPQ), by way of facsimile transmission and US-mail, to a pool of firms that have registered with OCI for the subject trade. Additionally, PWD advertises the project in the Daily Business Review as well as providing courtesy notifications in the Diario De Las Americas, Miami Herald, Miami Times, Haiti en Marche, Le Floridien, and Kiskeya Herald. Interested contractors prepare their bids according to the Job Order Contracting (JOC) process, whereby the County establishes unit prices for the pay items in accordance with industry averages. The contractors submit their bid as an overall percentage factor of the pricing established by the County. The project award evaluation is based upon the lowest percentage submitted by the responsive, responsible bidder for the project.

PWD staff submitted the referenced project to the Department of Business Development's (DBD) Review Committee. The Review Committee met on December 20, 2006, reviewed RPQ 20060358 and recommended no contract measures for this project. However, in order to expedite the project and in anticipation of receiving no contract measures from the Review Committee, PWD issued an RPQ on December 14, 2006, for a Traffic Signal Installation Contract and sent it to a list of 11 pre-registered firms from the OCI database as noted above. Three (3) firms purchased contract documents and two (2) firms proffered a bid. However, Magesco, Inc. a Community Small Business Enterprise (CSBE) firm has been declared not-responsible due to their poor performance on previous projects. The OCI database lists 17 performance evaluations for this firm. Of those, the two (2) most recent evaluations state the following: "Unresponsive performance documented in writing without timely corrective action."

The database lists 13 additional evaluations with the following comment: "Guarded performance - Errors and Omissions documented in writing with timely corrective action." Project Managers on current projects have also confirmed that Magesco, Inc. has not improved their performance following the most recent evaluations. Therefore, in accordance with Article 17 of the Special Provisions of the referenced project documents which state, ***"The award of contract, if it be made in the County's sole discretion, shall be to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder whose bid complies with all of the material terms of this solicitation and is determined to be in the best interest of the County. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the County may determine that it is in the County's best interest to award the contract to the next low bidder when the low bidder's existing contractual commitments with the County, in the sole discretion of the County (a) could prevent the timely prosecution of the work requiring competing commitments of site, supervisory or home office personnel, or (b) could present potential conflicts with billing of similar items under existing contracts for similar or related work, or (c) could disfavor competition in the contracting industry in pricing or in the use of personnel or subcontractors. By submitting a bid, the bidder acknowledges that the County shall have the right to investigate the existence of these factors in determining whether to award the bid, and to evaluate,***

without limitation, the bidder's outstanding commitments on other awarded contracts, its resources to perform the work under the contract, and its past performance, PWD has declared Magesco, Inc. not-responsible and is recommending award to the next lowest bidder. As a result, on February 2, 2007, PWD issued a recommendation of award for RPQ 20060358 with a percentage factor of 1.10 to Raydan Electric, Inc., also a CSBE firm, with the stipulation that approval of this project must be obtained from the BCC and the CITT due to guidelines associated with the funding source. Raydan Electric, Inc.'s bid is 2% higher than the bid proffered by Magesco, Inc., and both firms are CSBE.

The work to be accomplished for this project consists of, but is not limited to, furnishing all supervision, labor, required materials, and equipment and tools to perform traffic signal installation(s) including any ancillary work at the intersection of Hialeah Gardens Boulevard and West 80 Street. The contractor shall furnish and install grounding electrodes, conduits, pull boxes, foundations, overhead signs (Internally Illuminated LED signs), mounting hardware, signal cable, power cable and power services. Additional work to be performed includes installing six (6) vehicle detection loops, four (4) traffic signal poles, signage, new pavement markings, and removing existing signs, and old pavement markings in conflict with the proposed work. The base contract amount is \$142,234.28, but the total allocated amount is \$163,691.46, which is inclusive of the contingency and dedicated allowances.
