Subject: Resolution Authorizing the Approval of a County Deed to Vacate Certain Portions of County Canal Right-of-Way and Canal Maintenance Easement Which Are No Longer Needed by Miami-Dade County in the South One-Half (S½) of Section 26 & Section 35, Township 52 South, Range 39 East (WC-864)

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board approve the attached Resolution authorizing the approval of a County Deed to vacate certain portions of canal right-of-way and maintenance easement which are no longer needed.


Background

On September 29, 1970 and on May 9, 1973, Miami-Dade County acquired, at no cost, canal right-of-way and canal maintenance easement by virtue of deeds from Maule Industries, Inc., recorded respectively in the Official Records Book 7196 at Page 67 and Official Records Book 8618 at Page 2135 of Miami-Dade County, Florida. Said canal interests located east of, and parallel to, NW 137 Avenue were acquired by Miami-Dade County in compliance with the requirements of the Water Control Master Plan for flood protection and water management.

In 1989, the Department of Environmental Resources Management (DERM), in a cooperative project with the South Florida Water Management District and the Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department, implemented the Northwest Wellfield Protection Plan. Under this plan, a canal with adequate capacity to resupply the wellfield was constructed to connect the Levee L-30 Canal to the Snapper Creek Extension Canal. The location selected for the final alignment of the Northwest Wellfield Protective Canal was through the center of the aforesaid Section 26, in an east-west direction. Consequently, those canal interests running parallel to NW 137 Avenue were no longer needed. The necessary canal right-of-way and maintenance easements for the aforesaid Northwest Wellfield Protective Canal were acquired following the final alignment described above.

Tarmac America LLC is the owner of the land described as the South One-Half (S½) of Section 26 & Section 35, Township 52 South, Range 39 East, where those canal interests are located. An application for the vacation by Miami-Dade County of said interests had been submitted by the aforementioned owner as successor in interest to Maule Industries, Inc., pursuant to the reversionary provision of the conveyance deed to Miami-Dade County.

DERM has reviewed this request and recommends approval of the attached County Deed.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPROVAL OF A COUNTY DEED TO VACATE CERTAIN PORTIONS OF COUNTY CANAL RIGHT-OF-WAY AND CANAL MAINTENANCE EASEMENT WHICH ARE NO LONGER NEEDED BY MIAMI-DADE COUNTY IN THE SOUTH ONE-HALF (S½) OF SECTION 26 & SECTION 35, TOWNSHIP 52 SOUTH, RANGE 39 EAST

WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes set forth in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board authorizes the approval of a County Deed to vacate certain portions of an existing 70-foot canal right-of-way and 25-foot canal maintenance easement no longer needed by Miami-Dade County and located in the South One-Half (S½) of Section 26 & Section 35, Township 52 South, Range 39 East, in Miami-Dade County, Florida; and authorizes execution of said County Deed by the Mayor in substantially the form attached hereto and made a part hereof.

WITNESSETH:

That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) to it in hand paid by the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained and sold to the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns forever, the following described lands, acquired by Deed, Easement, Reservation, or otherwise as shown in Exhibit "A", for a secondary canal system, in Sections 26 & 35, Township 52 South, Range 39 East, all situate, lying and being in the County of Miami-Dade, and more specifically described as follows:



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
