RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MANAGER TO
INITIATE EDUCATIONAL/AWARENESS CAMPAIGN
ADVISING PUBLIC OF DANGERS OF UTILIZING CRUISE
CONTROL DURING CONDITIONS OF INCLEMENT
WEATHER

WHEREAS, cruise control utilized in wet conditions can cause hydroplaning; and

WHEREAS, cruise control utilized on wet or slippery roads can cause a loss of control
of the motor vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Marine Corps, the State of Washington, the State of Utah, the State
of California and the American Automobile Association have recognized the danger posed by
the use of cruise control in inclement weather,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board hereby
directs the County Manager to initiate an educational/awareness campaign advising the public in
Miami-Dade County of the dangers posed by utilizing cruise control during conditions of
inclement weather.




