

matter shall be limited to departmental items and shall be non-delegable. The Board will not consider any such recommendation unless such recommendation has been approved in writing by the mayor. If, however, the mayor shall be incapacitated for a period in excess of _____ days, his or her authority to sponsor a departmental item shall be vested in the manager until the incapacity is removed. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the manager shall be able to recommend directly to the Board the waiver of competitive bidding as provided in Section 5.03 (D) of the Charter or quasi-judicial items.<<

* * *

Section 2. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this ordinance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected by such invalidity.

Section 3. It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners, and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this ordinance, including any sunset provision, shall become and be made a part of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida. The sections of this ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such intention, and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section," "article," or other appropriate word.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective ten (10) days after the date of enactment unless vetoed by the Mayor, and if vetoed, shall become effective only upon an override by this Board.
