RESOLUTION NO. R-680-07

RESOLUTION URGING THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT AND THE GOVERNOR, FLORIDA'S ATTORNEY GENERAL AND OTHER APPROPRIATE OFFICIALS TO LAUNCH AN INVESTIGATION INTO HIGH GASOLINE PRICES

WHEREAS, gasoline prices are continuing to rise with no end in sight; and

WHEREAS, such gasoline price increases are detrimental to all the citizens of Miami-Dade County and especially those citizens on fixed and limited incomes; and

WHEREAS, working families in Miami-Dade County are suffering under the economic stress caused by these increasing gasoline prices,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Urges the federal government and the Governor, Florida's Attorney General and other appropriate officials to launch an investigation into high gasoline prices.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit certified copies of the resolution to the Florida Congressional Delegation, the Governor, the Florida Attorney General, the Florida Commissioner of Agriculture and Consumer Services, and the Chair and Members of the Miami-Dade State Legislative Delegation.

Section 3. Directs the County's federal and state lobbyists to advocate for the actions set forth in Section 1 and directs the Office of Intergovernmental Affairs to include this item in the 2007 and 2008 Federal and State Legislative Packages.

The foregoing resolution was sponsored by Commissioner Dennis C. Moss and offered by Commissioner Sally A. Heyman, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Bruno A. Barreiro and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:




