RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PLAT OF BOREK,
LOCATED IN THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 19,
TOWNSHIP 56 SOUTH, RANGE 40 EAST (SW 240 STREET
AND SW 117 AVENUE)

WHEREAS, MD Holdings LXIX, LLC, a Florida limited liability company, has this day presented to this Board a plat of certain lands lying in Miami-Dade County, Florida, said plat to be known as BOREK, the same being a subdivision of a portion of land lying and being in the Northwest 1/4 of Section 19, Township 56 South, Range 40 East, and a replat of a portion of Tract 6 of "2nd Amended Plat of Portions of South Miami Gardens", according to the plat thereof, as recorded in Plat Book 48, at Page 28, of the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida, lying and being in the Northwest 1/4 of Section 19, Township 56 South, Range 40 East, Miami-Dade County, Florida, and it appears that all requirements of law concerning said plat insofar as the authority of this Board is concerned have been complied with,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that said plat is hereby approved; that the dedication of the streets, alleys and other rights-of-way however designated or depicted on said plat is hereby accepted; that the Miami-Dade County Plat Restrictions as listed on said plat are approved and are to be enforced; that approval of the plat is not a waiver of any zoning regulations and that the requirements of the zoning existing on this land at the time this resolution is approved shall be enforced



RECOMMENDATION

The following plat meets concurrency and is hereby submitted for consideration by the Board of County Commissioners for approval. The Miami-Dade County Plat Committee recommends approval and recording of the plat listed below. This plat is bounded on the north by approximate SW 238 Street, on the east by approximate SW 114 Court, on the south by SW 240 Street, and on the west by SW 117 Avenue.

BACKGROUND

BOREK (T-22455)

- Located in Section 19, Township 56 South, Range 40 East
- Commission District: 8
- Zoning: RU-1M(A)
- Proposed Usage: Single family residences
- Number of parcels: 69

PLAT RESTRICTIONS

- That SW 238th Terrace, SW 239th Terrace, SW 240th Street, SW 114th Place, SW 115th Avenue, SW 115th Court, SW 116th Court and SW 117th Avenue, as shown on the plat, together with all existing and future planting, trees, shrubbery and fire hydrants thereon, are hereby dedicated to the perpetual use of the public for proper purposes, reserving to the dedicators, their successors or assigns, the reversion or reversions thereof whenever discontinued by law.
- That individual wells shall not be permitted within this subdivision, except for swimming pools, sprinkler systems and/or air conditioners.

- That the use of septic tanks will not be permitted on any lot within this subdivision, unless approved for temporary use, in accordance with County and State regulations.
- That all new electric and communication lines, except transmission lines, within this subdivision, shall be installed underground.
- That the utility easements, shown by dashed lines on the plat, are hereby reserved for the installation and maintenance of public utilities and drainage facilities.

DEVELOPER'S OBLIGATION

- Paving, sidewalks, street name signs, drainage, curb and gutter, removal of guardrail, concrete decorative wall, traffic control signs, striping and monumentation. Bonded under bond number 7706 for the amount of \$533,128.00.
