**RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MANAGER TO  
STUDY THE FEASIBILITY AND ADVISABILITY OF  
INCREASING THE USE OF MOTORCYCLES BY THE  
MIAMI-DADE COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT**

**WHEREAS**, motor vehicle traffic is increasing every year in Miami-Dade County; and

**WHEREAS**, a recent study by Autovantage ranked Miami drivers number one (1) in road rage and “the worst drivers” in the United States; and

**WHEREAS**, in an attempt to reduce the incidents of road rage and improve motor vehicle safety, the Board wishes to increase the number of the motorcycle police patrolling in Miami-Dade County,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board directs the County Manager to study the feasibility and advisability of increasing the use of motorcycles by the Miami-Dade Police Department in order to reduce the incidents of road rage and improve motor vehicle safety. The County Manager shall submit the report within thirty (30) days from the adoption of this resolution and said report will be considered by the Board at the upcoming budget hearings in the Fall of 2007.




