RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE MIAMI-DADE TRANSIT AGENCY FOR THE JUNE 18-24, 2007 DRUG EDUCATION FOR YOUTH (DEFY) CAMP SPONSORED BY THE MIAMI/MIAMI-DADE WEED & SEED, INC., A NOT-FOR-PROFIT ORGANIZATION, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,840.40 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE DISTRICT 3 IN-KIND RESERVE FUND

WHEREAS, the Miami/Miami-Dade Weed & Seed, Inc., has requested in-kind services from the Miami-Dade Transit Agency for the June 18-24, 2007 Drug Education For Youth (DEFY) Camp in an amount not to exceed \$2,840.40 (see attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application); and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Drug Education For Youth (DEFY) Camp is to allow youths the opportunity to participate in a drug resistance education curriculum, which will enhance their self-esteem, character building skills and motivational development; and

WHEREAS, the Miami/Miami-Dade Weed & Seed, Inc. is a not-for-profit organization; and

WHEREAS, the Drug Education For Youth (DEFY) Camp is a small event, as defined in the attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application and the in-kind services shall be funded from the District 3 In-kind Reserve Fund,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board retroactively authorizes in-kind services from the Miami-Dade Transit Agency for the June 18-24, 2007 Drug Education For Youth (DEFY) Camp event in an amount not to exceed \$2,840.00 to be funded from the District 3 In-kind Reserve Fund.





Subject: District Specific In-Kind Request Recommendation

The Office of Strategic Business Management (OSBM) has reviewed the attached in-kind request and recommends for the item to move forward to the Board of County Commissioners for consideration. The district specific in-kind reserve balance allows for the funding of this request.

Background

A retroactive waiver for in-kind services has been requested by a not-for-profit organization Miami/Miami-Dade Weed 2 Seed, Inc., for their DEFY Camp held on June 18-24, 2007.

In-kind services have been requested in an amount not to exceed \$2,840.40 from the Miami-Dade Transit Agency for transportation services. This event will be funded from the District 3 in-kind reserve fund.

In FY 2006-07, Miami/Miami-Dade Weed 2 Seed, Inc. has not received any County funding for this event.
