RESOLUTION NO. R-1109-07

RESOLUTION URGING THE CITY OF MIAMI TO PASS A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE DESIGNATION OF W. FLAGLER STREET FROM 67<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE TO 72<sup>ND</sup> AVENUE AS "ARNOLD M. VELAZQUEZ BOULEVARD"

**WHEREAS**, during the 2007 regular session, the Florida Legislature passed CS/SB 138, which among other road designations, designates W. Flagler Street from 67<sup>th</sup> Avenue to 72<sup>nd</sup> Avenue as "Arnold M. Velazquez Boulevard"; and

**WHEREAS**, section 334.071, Florida Statutes, provides that the installation of road designation signs shall be contingent on the applicable city commission passing a resolution in support of the particular honorary road designation; and

**WHEREAS**, before the Florida Department of Transportation will install signs reflecting the Arnold M. Velazquez Boulevard road designation, the Miami City Commission will need to pass a resolution in support of the road designation,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board:

Section 1. Urges the City of Miami to pass this resolution supporting the designation of W. Flagler Street from 67<sup>th</sup> Avenue to 72<sup>nd</sup> Avenue as "Arnold M. Velazquez Boulevard."

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit certified copies of this resolution to the Mayor and members of the Miami City Commission.

The foregoing resolution was sponsored by Commissioner Rebeca Sosa and Commissioner Jose "Pepe" Diaz and offered by Commissioner Jose "Pepe" Diaz, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Dennis C. Moss and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:




