RESOLUTION DIRECTING UTILIZATION OF COLORED
PRINT ON THE COUNTY'S TRIM NOTICE AND TAX BILL

WHEREAS, in accordance with state law all owners of real and personal property in Miami-Dade County are provided in August and November of each year with a notice of proposed property taxes and non-ad valorem assessments (trim notice) and a combined notice of ad valorem taxes and non-ad valorem assessments (tax bill); and

WHEREAS, it would assist taxpayers if these notices reflected in different colored print the amount of taxes to be collected by each taxing authority,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the County Manager is hereby directed to cause the County Property Appraiser and Tax Collector, in November 2007 to commence utilizing colored print on the tax bill and trim notice differentiating county taxes from those collected by the County School Board and municipalities. In the event utilization of colored print will result in additional costs to the County, the need for using an outside vendor or the need to delay implementation of this resolution, this information shall be reported back to the Board of County Commissioners for consideration.

The foregoing resolution was sponsored by Commissioner Natacha Seijas and offered by Commissioner Jose "Pepe" Diaz, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Bruno A. Barreiro and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:


