RESOLUTION NO. R- 920-07

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO CONDUCT COUNTY BUSINESS DURING THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' SUMMER 2007 RECESS; THE AUTHORIZATION PERIOD WILL BEGIN AT THE ADJOURNMENT OF THE JULY 24, 2007 BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' MEETING AND CONCLUDE AUGUST 24, 2007; AND SUBSEQUENTLY ALL ITEMS WILL BE SUBMITTED TO THE BOARD FOR RATIFICATION AT THE OCTOBER 2, 2007 BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MEETING

WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board hereby authorizes the County Mayor or his designee to administer County business during the Board of County Commissioners 2007 summer recess. This authority would include: award of contracts and approval of change orders required to maintain essential health and safety activities pursuant to approved County procedures; application for grants; execution of grant agreements and other intergovernmental cooperation agreements; compliance with court orders; and amendment of the Project Cooperation Agreement between the Department of the Army and Miami-Dade County, Florida for construction and operation of a dredged Material Management Facility at the Miami River, Florida Federal Navigation Project. The authorization period will begin at the adjournment of the July 24, 2007 Board of County Commissioners meeting and conclude on August 24, 2007. Subsequently, all items will be submitted to the Board for ratification at its October 2, 2007 Board meeting.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner Carlos A. Gimenez who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Bruno A. Barriero and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) authorize the County Mayor or his designee to conduct County business during the Board of County Commissioners Summer 2007 Recess, beginning with adjournment of the July 24, 2007 Board of County Commissioners meeting and concluding on August 24, 2007.

Scope

The proposed resolution will not have a particular impact upon a Commission district.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

The proposed resolution will not have a fiscal impact to Miami-Dade County.

Track Record/Monitor

This agenda item does not contain a contract.

Background

The Board in previous years has granted temporary authorization to the County Manager to conduct official County business during the summer recess period. This authority would include:

- award of contracts and approval of change orders required to maintain essential health and safety activities pursuant to approved County procedures;
- application for grants; execution of grant agreements and other intergovernmental cooperation agreements;
- compliance with court orders

In all cases where the delegation of authority is exercised such action would be in accordance with established County policies and procedures, including prior review for legal sufficiency by the County Attorney. As was the case last year, I can assure you that this delegation of authority will only be used where items are time critical, and any ratification action will be kept to a minimum.

Items approved under the ratification authority will be scheduled for the appropriate committee of jurisdiction and will be submitted to the Board for ratification at the October 2, 2007 Board of County Commissioners meeting.
