RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE MIAMI-DADE TRANSIT AGENCY FOR THE SEPTEMBER 13, 2007 YOUTH CIVIC INVOLVEMENT CONFERENCE SPONSORED BY UNIDAD OF MIAMI BEACH, INC., A NOT-FOR-PROFIT ORGANIZATION, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$605.00 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE DISTRICT 5 IN-KIND RESERVE FUND

WHEREAS, Unidad of Miami Beach, Inc. has requested in-kind services from the Miami-Dade Transit Agency for the September 13, 2007 Youth Civic Involvement Conference event in an amount not to exceed \$605.00 (see attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application); and


The Chairperson thereupon declared the resolution duly passed and adopted this 6th day

The New Generation Leadership & Workforce Institute Holds Its Second Annual Youth Civic Involvement Conference

Miami, FL – On Thursday, September 13th, over 200 youth will converge at Kovens Conference Center on Florida International University's Biscayne Bay campus to participate in a full day of civic leadership development. These remarkable 14-18 year old students will travel from all corners of Miami-Dade County to engage in the Second Annual Youth Civic Involvement Conference, the theme of which is *Beyond the Profit: The Path to a Public Service Career and Social Enterprises*. The conference is a valuable component of the New Generation Leadership & Workforce Institute, a program operated by UNIDAD of Miami Beach, Inc.

Activities will take place from 9 AM – 5 PM at the Kovens Conference Center, 3000 N.E. 151st Street, Miami, Florida 33181. Three exceptional youth will be receiving Civic Leadership Awards for their dedication to the betterment of their communities and themselves: Antoinella Scarsano, Jose Floyd and Angela Pierre. Workshops will be held in the areas of global youth diplomacy, college and career preparation, development of social enterprises, and creating a winning empowerment plan for life. Youth will have the unique opportunity to discuss conference topics with special guests and facilitators at roundtable discussions.

Attendees will enjoy a sit-down luncheon featuring keynote speaker Nelson Santiago, Ph. D., Chairman of the Puerto Rican/Hispanic Chamber of Commerce of Broward County and South Florida Territory Manager for the IT consulting firm Solusoft. Juan Casimiro and his Insight, LLC team have developed an impressive roster of dynamic educators, including Annette Alvarez, Francisco Pardo, Lee Luna and Nathan Burrell to facilitate the aforementioned training sessions. The event will close with eight outstanding youth participants presenting a summary of what they have learned and their action plans for continuing to prioritize these vital issues within the youth community.

Funded by the South Florida Workforce Investment Board and The Children's Trust and made possible by support from the City of Miami Beach, the innovative program bringing these young people together was created at non-profit organization UNIDAD of Miami Beach, Inc in 2005. Since the initial summer program in that year, the NGLWI has graduated 185 accomplished alumni and grown to reach over 300 youth during its summer and year-round components. The majority of these youth were hired by UNIDAD as Leadership Students, gaining knowledge in a wide array of subjects such as employability, entrepreneurial and leadership skills during their first paying job.

Subject: District Specific In-Kind Request Recommendation

The Office of Strategic Business Management (OSBM) has reviewed the attached in-kind request and recommends for the item to move forward to the Board of County Commissioners for consideration. The district specific in-kind reserve balance allows for the funding of this request.

Background

A retroactive waiver for in-kind services has been requested by a not-for-profit organization Unidad of Miami Beach, Inc. for the "Youth Civic Involvement Conference" held on September 13, 2007.

In-kind services have been requested in an amount not to exceed \$605 from the Miami-Dade Transit Agency for transportation services. This event will be funded from the District 5 in-kind reserve fund.

In FY 2006-07, Unidad of Miami Beach, Inc. received \$283,000 from the Office of Community and Economic Development.
