

RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING SW 97TH
AVENUE FROM KILLIAN PARKWAY (SW 112TH
STREET) TO SW 104TH STREET AS COUGAR
WAY

WHEREAS, this Board has conducted a public hearing to consider codesignating SW 97th Avenue from Killian Parkway (SW 112th Street) to SW 104th Street as Cougar Way; and

WHEREAS, to say that Miami Killian Senior High School is a fantastic school is to undermine its true excellence. In fact, Miami Killian Senior High School exudes excellence, talent and brilliance from every pore of this institution, academically and athletically alike; and

WHEREAS, Miami Killian Senior High School is a school which has an eclectic culture and invaluable talent; while a sole street sign is not necessarily capable of unifying and empowering an entire student body, it is symbolic of the greater picture; and

WHEREAS, Miami Killian Senior High School is known across the county, the region, and the state for its superior student programs; and

WHEREAS, Miami Killian Senior High School's mascot is the Cougar; and

WHEREAS, on behalf of the Principal of Miami Killian Senior High School and the entire Cougar family we honor a school which bears countless state championships, awards and honorable recognition, we ask your support in this codesignation; and

WHEREAS, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 8,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. This Board approves the codesignation of SW 97th Avenue from Killian Parkway (SW 112th Street) to SW 104th Street as Cougar Way.

Section 2. The Clerk of the Board is hereby directed to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works Department and Land Development Division of the Public Works Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.
