Subject: Resolution Ratifying the County Mayor's Actions in the Certification of a Valid Public Emergency Pursuant to Florida Statutes and in Authorizing the Selection of an Engineering Consultant for Venetian Causeway Bridges Rehabilitation

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) ratify the County Mayor's action in certifying a valid public emergency pursuant to Section 287.055(3)(a)(1), Florida Statutes and in authorizing the selection of an engineering consultant to prepare plans for urgently required and critical structural repairs for the Venetian Causeway system of bridges.

Scope

The Venetian Causeway is located within Commission Districts 3 and 4.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

Causeway Toll Revenues in the amount of \$269,393.00 will be utilized to compensate the engineering consultant for the required design services.

Track Record/Monitor

The engineering consultant selected to perform design work for the rehabilitation of the bridges is Triangle Associates, Inc. (TAI). TAI has been awarded eight (8) contracts in the past five (5) years, for a total of \$1,659,011.00. There is one Architectural/Engineering Services Performance Evaluation on file in the Office of Capital Improvements' Consultant Evaluation System. The evaluation was conducted by the County's Housing Agency and earned TAI an Overall Evaluation Rating of Acceptable (work quality is acceptable and meets all contract requirements), with a special rating of Superior (work quality is outstanding, work is provided on or ahead of schedule) in the area of construction management.

Background

The Public Works Department (PWD) has routinely monitored the overall condition of all bridges and spans in Miami-Dade County, including the Venetian Causeway system comprised of 12 bridges (the bridges). Since September, 2004, PWD has utilized the engineering consulting firm TAI to perform studies, field inspections and to prepare reports as to the structural condition of the bridges. The aforementioned studies detail many deficiencies, both structural and aesthetic, including corrosion of metal structures critical to the structural integrity of the bridges. Plans, design documents and necessary technical specifications for the construction contract documents are required to complete urgently needed repairs.

Due to the sensitive nature of the structural repairs needed on the bridges, PWD concluded that selecting an engineering consultant through a competitive selection process would consume valuable time and potentially compromise the structural integrity of the bridges. Consequently, PWD sought and obtained, in accordance to Section 287.055, Florida Statutes, certification by the Mayor that a valid public emergency exists with respect to the condition of the bridges. The mayoral action, on September 7, 2007, allowed PWD to select an engineering consultant without using a competitive selection process. The selected consultant, TAI, in addition to performing studies, conducting inspections and preparing reports related to the condition of the bridges, has developed computer software specific to the types of repairs required for

said bridges, and has also prepared extensive documentation detailing the rehabilitation effort. TAI will only prepare the design documents and necessary technical specifications for construction contract documents required to complete urgently needed repairs. In accordance with the emergency authorization signed by the Mayor, on September 12, 2007, PWD issued a Work Order in the amount of \$269,393.00 to TAI directing them to perform all required engineering design services for the rehabilitation of the bridges. The Notice to Proceed was issued on September 17, 2007, with an estimated completion date of January 14, 2008.

The time savings attributable to the Mayoral certification of a valid public emergency with respect to the condition of the Venetian Causeway system of bridges is conservatively estimated at 9 months. In order to accelerate the bridges' replacement process and further reap the benefits of this time savings PWD will concurrently initiate the process of selecting the contractor to perform the required construction and construction management work on the bridges through a formal competitive process. The design phase will be completed in late January, 2008. The cost of structurally necessary repairs is estimated at approximately \$11 million, to be jointly funded by the Florida Department of Transportation and the County; PWD will seek the Manager's approval to expedite the Request to Advertise and issue an emergency contract award once competitive bids are received. PWD estimates that repairs will be concluded 18 months after issuance of the NTP; the exact length of time will be determined by the plans.

RESOLUTION NO R-1320-07

RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE COUNTY MAYOR'S ACTIONS
IN THE CERTIFICATION OF A VALID PUBLIC EMERGENCY
PURSUANT TO FLORIDA STATUTES AND IN AUTHORIZING
THE SELECTION OF AN ENGINEERING CONSULTANT FOR
VENETIAN CAUSEWAY BRIDGES REHABILITATION

WHEREAS, the Venetian Causeway system of bridges presents structural deficiencies that need to be addressed without undue delay in the interest of public safety; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department concluded that selecting an engineering consultant through a competitive selection process would consume valuable time and potentially compromise the structural integrity of the Venetian Causeway bridges; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 287.055(3)(a)(1) of the Florida Statutes, on September 7, 2007 the County Mayor certified that a valid public emergency exists with respect to the condition of the Venetian Causeway bridges; and

WHEREAS, said Mayoral action of September 7, 2007 authorized the Public Works Department to select an engineering consultant without using a competitive selection process; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department determined that the firm Triangle Associates, Inc. (TAI) is the most suited to provide engineering consulting services for the rehabilitation of the Venetian Causeway bridges and, given the firm's unique experience, selected TAI to provide said engineering consulting services,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board finds in the best interest of the County to ratify the County Mayor's actions in the certification of a valid public

emergency pursuant to Florida Statutes and in authorizing the selection of an engineering consultant for the rehabilitation of the Venetian Causeway system of bridges, in substantially the form attached hereto and made a part hereof.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner **Jose "Pepe" Diaz**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Joe A. Martinez** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

Subject: Emergency Authorization to Select Consultant for Venetian Causeway Bridges Rehabilitation

The purpose of this memorandum is to request the Mayor's certification of a valid public emergency pursuant to Section 287.055(3)(a)(1), Florida Statutes, authorizing the selection of an engineering consultant to prepare plans for urgently required and critical structural repairs for the Venetian Causeway system of 12 bridges (the Bridges).

Section 287.055, Florida Statutes, requires the County (deemed to be an "agency" for the purposes of the Statute) to obtain engineering services through a competitive selection process "except in cases of valid public emergencies certified by the agency head" (Fla. Statute §287.055(3)(a)(1)). Due to the sensitive nature of the structural repairs needed on the Bridges the Public Works Department (PWD) has concluded that selecting an engineering consultant through a competitive selection process will consume valuable time and potentially compromise the structural integrity of the Bridges. Consequently, PWD seeks certification by the Mayor¹ that a valid public emergency exists with respect to the condition of the Bridges and allow PWD to select an engineering consultant without using a competitive selection process. The selected consultant will only prepare the design documents and necessary technical specifications for construction contract documents required to complete urgently needed repairs. In order to accelerate the Bridges' replacement process and further reap the benefits of this time savings PWD will concurrently initiate the process of selecting the contractor to perform the required construction and construction management work on the Bridges through a formal competitive process.

The consultant identified by PWD as best suited for the intended work is Triangle Associates, Inc. (TAI). Since September, 2004, TAI has been intimately involved in performing studies, field inspections, and preparing reports on the deficiencies in the Bridges. Furthermore, TAI has developed computer software specific to the types of repairs required for the Bridges, and has also prepared extensive documentation detailing the rehabilitation effort.

The above mentioned studies detail thousands of deficiencies, including cathodic protection to prevent corrosion of metal structures critical to the structural integrity of the Bridges, at a cost of approximately \$20 million. PWD has concluded that, at this time, it is in the best interest of the County to retain TAI only to prepare plans to perform those repairs that are of considerable structural significance and that may impact

public safety. PWD estimates that the construction contract to effect these repairs will cost approximately \$11 million and will seek the Manager's approval to expedite the Request to Advertise and issue an emergency contract award once competitive bids are received.

Because of the familiarity that TAI has with the condition of the bridges, PWD deems TAI ideally suited to perform the task most expeditiously. TAI estimates its fee will be \$269,393.00 to perform the design work for the repairs; funding for the design work will come from Causeway toll revenues. It is estimated that it will take 4 months from the date of the Notice to Proceed to complete the design work. If another consultant had to be selected to prepare the contract documents, the usual Request for Proposals (RFP) process would have to be initiated, resulting in delays and significantly higher costs. The Equitable Distribution Program (EDP) process, which is an expedited method of consultant selection is not an option in this particular case because the construction cost for the repairs will exceed the \$1 million threshold.

With respect to \$11 million in funds needed for the repairs, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) recently granted \$5.5 million to Miami-Dade County under the County Incentive Grant Program (CIGP) as follows: \$1.5 million for FY 06/07, \$1.6 million for FY 07/08 and \$2.4 million for FY 08/09. The County will match these funds utilizing a loan under the name of Sunshine State Financing. The loan is backed with a 15 year repayment plan from Causeway toll revenues.


In sum, because of the substantial and critical nature of the deterioration currently evident on the Bridges and because of the rapid and continuing decay caused by the low elevation of the Bridges in a very aggressive marine environment, PWD is seeking to expedite the rehabilitation work to protect public safety. Consequently, PWD submits this request to the Mayor to certify that a valid public emergency exists with respect to the condition of the Bridges, allowing PWD to select TAI to begin design work immediately.


