Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board authorize the establishment of the Miami Metrozoo Sami Trust Fund, to accept funds bequeathed by the late Albert Sami in the amount of \$2,307,684.36.

Scope

Miami Metrozoo is rated as one of the top ten zoos in the United States and is open to all visitors and residents of Miami-Dade County. The zoo is located at 12400 NW 152 Street in Commission District 9.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source


The donated funds will contribute toward the development and enhancement of Miami-Metrozoo as projects for use of the funds are identified.

Track Record/Monitor

All expenditures to be covered by the revenue in the Sami Trust Fund will be approved by the Park and Recreation Department Director.

Background

The Sami Family has been involved philanthropically with Miami Metrozoo and the Zoological Society of Florida for more than 15 years through a special relationship with Ron Magill, Zoo Communications Director and Goodwill Ambassador. As the primary spokesperson for the Zoo and recognized wildlife expert, Ron Magill has played a crucial role in Metrozoo since it opened in 1981. As a result of the relationship, Mr. Sami made provisions in his will to leave much of his estate to the Zoo with the stipulation that it be used as directed by Ron, as long as Ron continues to be associated with the Zoo. Mr. Sami's gift will be available to those areas where it can be most beneficial to Metrozoo and appreciated by generations of Zoo visitors in the future.
