**Subject:** Countywide In-Kind Request Recommendation

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The Office of Strategic Business Management (OSBM) has reviewed the attached in-kind request and recommends for the item to move forward to the Board of County Commissioners for consideration. The countywide in-kind reserve balance allows for the funding of this request.

## Background

A retroactive waiver for in-kind services has been requested by a not-for-profit organization the Gold Coast Railroad Museum, Inc. for their "Day Out With Thomas" event held on March 7-9 and March 14-16, 2007.

In-kind services have been requested in an amount not to exceed \$680 from the Miami-Dade Park and Recreation Department for use of a wheelchair lift and \$10,400 from the Miami-Dade Public Works Department for the use of 100 barricades for a total in-kind not to exceed \$11,080.
