

Subject: Ordinance delegating to the County Manager the authority to advertise contracts for construction and purchase of supplies, materials and services without prior commission approval

The fiscal impact of the ordinance delegating to the County Manager the authority to advertise contracts without prior commission approval cannot be easily quantified. While this delegation does not allow for a reduction in resources devoted to the procurement process, it does allow existing resources to be more efficient by reducing procurement cycle times approximately 68 -120 days.

ORDINANCE NO. 08-68

ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 07-76
PERTAINING TO THE COUNTY MANAGER'S AUTHORITY
TO ADVERTISE CONTRACTS FOR CONSTRUCTION AND
PURCHASES OF SUPPLIES, MATERIALS AND SERVICES
INCLUDING PROFESSIONAL SERVICES WITHOUT PRIOR
COMMISSION APPROVAL; DELETING SUNSET
PROVISION; PROVIDING SEVERABILITY, EXCLUSION
FROM THE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Ordinance 07-76 authorizes the County Manager to advertise contracts for construction and purchases of supplies, materials and services including professional services without prior Commission approval; and

WHEREAS, the County Manager is required to include in all advertisements the measures approved by the Review Committee relating to the County's small and community business programs; and

WHEREAS, the Commission Auditor shall periodically review and evaluate the Manager's exercise of authority and report the results of his or her review to this Board; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 07-76 by its terms sunsets on June 14, 2008 unless renewed annually by the Board; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of this Board to renew Ordinance 07-76 for one additional year,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. Section 5 of Ordinance 07-76 is hereby amended as follows:¹

¹ Words stricken through and/or [[double bracketed]] shall be deleted. Words underscored and/or >>double arrowed<< constitute the amendment proposed. Remaining provisions are now in effect and remain unchanged.

Section 5. ~~[[This Ordinance shall sunset one year after its effective date. The County Manager shall prepare an annual report for consideration by the Board prior to renewal]]~~ >>This Ordinance shall sunset on June 14, 2009. Thereafter, this Ordinance may be renewed for additional one year periods by resolution. The County Manager shall prepare an annual report for consideration by the Board prior to renewal.<<

Section 2. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this ordinance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected by such invalidity.


Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective within ten (10) days after the date of enactment unless vetoed by the Mayor, and if vetoed, shall become effective only upon an override by this Board.
