

RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE MIAMI-DADE TRANSIT AGENCY FOR THE MARCH 31, 2008 - APRIL 4, 2008 SPRING BREAK AQUATIC SAFETY AWARENESS PROGRAM SPONSORED BY SWEET VINE INCORPORATED, A NOT-FOR-PROFIT ORGANIZATION, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$4,500.00 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE DISTRICT 9 IN-KIND RESERVE FUND

WHEREAS, Sweet Vine, Inc. has requested in-kind services from the Miami-Dade Transit Agency for the March 31, 2008 - April 4, 2008 Spring Aquatic Safety Awareness program in an amount not to exceed \$4,500.00 (see attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application); and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Spring Aquatic Safety Awareness program is to provide youths an opportunity to develop swimming skills, to promote gun safety, and to provide a drug free atmosphere; and

WHEREAS, Sweet Vine Incorporated is a not-for-profit organization; and

WHEREAS, the Spring Aquatic Safety Awareness program is a special event, as that term is defined on the attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application, and the in-kind services shall be funded from the District 9 In-kind Reserve Fund,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board retroactively authorizes in-kind services from the Miami-Dade Transit Agency for the March 31, 2008 - April 4, 2008 Spring Aquatic Safety Awareness program in an amount not to exceed \$4,500.00 to be funded from the District 9 In-kind Reserve Fund.



Subject: District Specific In-Kind Reserve Request Recommendation

Recommendation

The Office of Strategic Business Management (OSBM) has reviewed the attached in-kind request and recommends for the item to move forward to the Board of County Commissioners for consideration. The district specific in-kind reserve balance allows for the funding of this request.

Background

A retroactive fee waiver for in-kind services is being requested by a not-for-profit organization Sweet Vine, Inc. for the Spring Break Aquatic Safety Awareness event held on March 31 – April 4, 2008.

In-kind services have been requested in an amount not to exceed \$4,500 from the Miami-Dade Transit Agency for shuttle transportation services. This event will be funded from the District 9 in-kind reserve fund.

In FY 2007-08, Sweet Vine, Inc. has received \$166,781 from the General Fund and \$1,000 from District 8 discretionary reserve.
