

RESOLUTION NO. R-923-08

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO STUDY AND TO SUBMIT A WRITTEN REPORT WITHIN FIVE (5) BUSINESS DAYS AS TO THE ADDITIONAL REVENUES TO BE EARNED BY INCREASING THE FARES FOR THE DADE-MONROE EXPRESS BUS ROUTE

WHEREAS, the Dade-Monroe Express Bus Route is one of the longest routes offered by Miami-Dade Transit, including stops in the Florida Keys; and

WHEREAS, an increase in fares on this route may serve to offset some of the costs for providing this service; and

WHEREAS, this commitment to increasing revenues for Miami-Dade Transit makes it more likely that Miami-Dade County will receive federal financial support for the North and East-West Corridor expansions of Metrorail,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board, hereby directs the County Mayor or his designee to study and to submit a written report within five (5) business days as to the additional revenues to be earned by increasing the fares for the Dade-Monroe Express Bus Route. Said report shall include, but not be limited to, the daily ridership numbers for this route, the current revenues generated by fares on this route, and projected revenues to be earned if there are fare increases at twenty five cent increments.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Dorrin D. Rolle.
