

RECOMMENDATION

This Recommendation to Award a construction Contract No. S-811 (A) between Skanska USA Building, Inc. and Miami-Dade County in the amount of \$92,786,510.28 has been prepared by the Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department (WASD) and is recommended for approval pursuant to Miami-Dade County Code, Section 2-8.2.11, WASD Contracting Authority. This project is one in a series of projects under the High Level Disinfection (HLD) Program to comply with Consent Order No. 03-1376 negotiated by the County and the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP), and to adhere to regulatory requirements resulting from a rule change implemented by the US Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) to meet effluent quality standards for deep well disposal. Upon the completion of the entire project, the South District Wastewater Treatment Plant (SDWWTP) will be rated as a 285 million gallons per day (MGD) plant.

DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY

The authority of the County Mayor or his designee to execute and implement this contract is consistent with those authorities granted under the Code of Miami-Dade County.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The work consists of furnishing all materials, labor, and equipment necessary for the construction of four new secondary clarifiers, specifically, Clarifiers 7 through 10, and the refurbishment of six existing secondary clarifiers, specifically, Clarifiers 1 through 6, at the SDWWTP located at 23300 SW 88 Avenue in Miami-Dade County, Florida.

For the construction of four new secondary clarifier structures, specifically Clarifiers 7 through 10, the scope of work includes: hydraulic testing of structure, installation and testing of clarifiers equipment with all appurtenances; modification and testing of existing secondary clarifiers,

specifically, Clarifiers 1 through 6, including cleaning, repairing and recoating the tanks, installation of new drives, new center column, and all other associated items and accessories; furnishing and installing 60-inch, 72-inch, 84-inch, 96-inch, and 108-inch pre-stressed concrete cylinder pipe (PCCP), and other related items and accessories; demolition of some structures; removal of irrigation lines and relocation of duct banks, water meters, street lights, pull boxes, conduits, and wiring; construction of a polymer building structure, including HVAC, electrical, piping, instrumentation, and all appurtenances; modification of Returned Activated Sludge (RAS) Pump Station No. 2, including changing the design from dry well to wet well with new submersible pumps, bar screens, and all appurtenances; construction of a new RAS Pump Station No. 3, including wet wells, submersible pumps, bar screens, and all appurtenances; modification of effluent flumes of the existing Oxygenation Tanks No.'s 1 through 6; removal and disposal of 60-inch and 72-inch PCCP; furnishing and installing 60-inch, 72-inch, and 96-inch butterfly valves with operators, actuators, and manhole with covers; sheet piling and dewatering; site work; paving work; yard piping; electrical work; mechanical work; and all other appurtenants and miscellaneous items.

It is WASD's intent to obtain a complete functional, and satisfactory installation under this project, and any items of labor, equipment or materials which may be reasonably assumed as necessary to accomplish this end shall be supplied whether or not they are specifically shown on the plans or stated in the specifications. The contractor shall provide all sheeting, shoring, bracing and all other labor, material or equipment required to preclude damage to, or loss of functionality of, any existing facility or system.



Subject: CSBE Compliance Review of Project No: S-811(A), South District Wastewater Treatment Plant, HLD Upgrade to 285 MGD, Secondary Clarifier Additions and Improvements

Small Business Development (SBD) has completed a compliance review for the above-referenced project with the Community Small Business Enterprise (CSBE) Program. The contract measure applicable to this project is a 3.8% first tier CSBE subcontractor goal and a 6.79% second, third, and fourth tier CSBE goal. The Construction Contracts Section of The Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department (WASD) submitted bid documents from Skanska USA Building, Inc. and Poole and Kent Company of Florida for compliance review.

Skanska USA Building, Inc. submitted the required Schedule of Intent (SOI) Affidavit committing to utilize Merkury Development, a certified CSBE firm, to perform concrete and masonry work at 3.8% to meet the first tier CSBE subcontractor goal. Merkury Development signed the SOI Affidavit in agreement with the information listed. A commitment letter was also submitted by Skanska USA Building, Inc. agreeing to meet the second, third, and fourth tier CSBE goal. Skanska USA Building, Inc. has fulfilled the contract measure requirement and is in compliance with the CSBE Participation Provisions.

Poole and Kent Company of Florida submitted the required SOI Affidavits committing to utilize Dodec, Inc., a certified CSBE firm, to furnish and install mechanical work at 3.5% and Rashids Enterprises Unlimited Inc., a certified CSBE firm, to perform painting work at .5% to meet the first tier CSBE subcontractor goal. Each subcontractor signed its respective SOI Affidavit in agreement with the information listed. A commitment letter was also submitted by Poole and Kent Company of Florida agreeing to meet the second, third, and fourth tier CSBE goal. Poole and Kent Company of Florida has fulfilled the contract measure requirement and is in compliance with the CSBE Participation Provisions.

SBD staff only reviewed and addressed compliance with the CSBE program. The Construction Contracts Section of The Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department is responsible for any other issues that may exist.
