

RESOLUTION NO. R-783-08

RESOLUTION JOINING THE CITY OF MIAMI AND  
APPROVING THE STATE ROAD DESIGNATION OF N.W.  
7<sup>th</sup> STREET BETWEEN N.W. 37<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE AND N.W.  
38<sup>TH</sup> COURT AS ISADORE HECHT STREET

**WHEREAS**, Isadore Hecht was a man of vision credited as one of the individuals who made Greyhound racing popular throughout the United States; and

**WHEREAS**, Isadore Hecht developed the major stake race in Greyhound racing by conceiving the idea of the International Classic with a purse in the \$100,000 range; and

**WHEREAS**, the International Classic attracted the public's attention and Hecht continued to make awareness of the Greyhound industry commonplace through strong promotions and by giving customers what they wanted; and

**WHEREAS**, Hecht also introduced the quiniela tote board, he made dining at a track a lavish experience, and he developed the racing theatre concept; and

**WHEREAS**, during the 2007 regular session, the Florida Legislature passed Senate Bill 138, which among other road designations, designates N.W. 7<sup>th</sup> Street between N.W. 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue and N.W. 38<sup>th</sup> Court as Isadore Hecht Street; and

**WHEREAS**, Florida Statutes 334.071 provides that the erection of markers shall be contingent upon the appropriate city or county commission passing a resolution in support of the particular honorary designation; and

**WHEREAS**, on September 27, 2007 the City of Miami passed resolution R-07-0538, approving this state road designation; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board joins the City of Miami in approving the state road designation of N.W. 7<sup>th</sup> Street between N.W. 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue and N.W. 38<sup>th</sup> Court as Isadore Hecht Street.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Rebeca Sosa. It was offered by Commissioner Rebeca Sosa, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Jose "Pepe" Diaz and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
