Subject: Contract Award Recommendation for Oleta River State Park Mitigation - Project No: 2007.013; Contract No: 2007.013, to Solo Construction Corporation

RECOMMENDATION

This Request to Rescind the previous Recommendation for Award to U.S. Bridge & Dredge, Inc. and the Recommendation for Award to the second lowest bidder for Construction Contract No. 2007.013 between Solo Construction Corporation and Miami-Dade County has been prepared by Miami-Dade Seaport Department and is recommended for approval.

Delegation of Authority - The authority of the County Mayor or his designee to execute and implement this contract is consistent with those authorities granted under the Code of Miami-Dade County. Additional delegation of authorities requested for this contract are as follows:

The General Conditions for the Contract, Article 42, "Disputes," Section B states that any and all disputes shall be decided by the Contracting Officer. The contract stipulates that the Contracting Officer for this contract is the Director of the Miami-Dade Seaport Department and/or his/her designee.

PROJECT NAME: Oleta River State Park Mitigation

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Seaport Department has the need to secure one (1) General Contractor to mitigate 62.5 acres with red mangroves (Rhizophora mangle) mitigation within the Oleta River State Park in North Miami, Florida. Work conducted within the park will include the creation/restoration of 42.5 acres of red mangrove swamp, tidal streams and tidal pools and the enhancement of 20.0 acres of impounded red mangrove through restored hydration. Of the 42.5 acres of habitat to be restored, 25 acres will be planted and the remaining 17.5 acres will vegetate via natural recruitment (not planted) or will be planted using volunteers (local high school students or other volunteer programs). This project has stringent grading requirements (within 0.10 of a foot) and detailed tidal pools and flushing channels to ensure wetland survival. Additionally, the Port will be creating and installing a minimum of two bi-lingual environmental education signs at site locations approved by the park manager. Mitigation activities will be conducted according to the

requirements of a Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) Consent Order (OGC File No. 01-0647-13-DF), executed on May 7, 2002 and associated environmental permits.

SBD HISTORY OF VIOLATIONS: Yes- Report Attached SBD Violations report lists one violation for this Company dated March 23, 2007. The report also shows that this violation has been resolved.

EXPLANATION:

The project was advertised on September 4, 2007. Seven bids were received on October 5, 2007. US Bridge & Dredge, Inc., submitted a base bid of \$2,038,704.01 and was found to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. The award of this contract was approved by the Board of County Commissioners on March 4, 2008. Upon request to submit the payment and performance bond, US Bridge & Dredge, Inc., submitted a bond that did not comply with the requirements set forth in the contract. At the Contractor's request, additional time was allowed to re-submit the required bond. US Bridge & Dredge, Inc. was unable to comply with the requirements; therefore, the Seaport is proceeding to rescind the original award. At this time, the Seaport is working with the County Attorney's Office to collect payment from US Bridge & Dredge, Inc., for the additional cost incurred by the County for their failure to submit the required payment & performance bond.

The second lowest bidder, Solo Construction Corporation, submitted a base bid of \$2,057,170.46, and has been found to be the next lowest responsive and responsible bidder. The base estimate included within the Request to Advertise (\$1,769,911.51) was revised during the bidding period in response to questions raised by potential bidders. The revised base estimate, \$1,865,460.40, includes additional bid line items and deletions of bid line items. The base bid amount submitted by Solo Construction Corporation is 16.2% above the original base estimate and 10.27% above the revised base estimate.

On February 27, 2008, the Board of County Commissioners approved a Settlement Agreement (Resolution No. R-192-08) between Solo Construction Corporation and Miami-Dade County (Circuit Court Case No. 06-00825 CA 02) relating to the construction of the Midfield Expansion Phase III, Project No. 95-087M-11 at Miami International Airport. The amount of the settlement was \$2,250,000, from which \$136,598.41 representing wage underpayments was withheld. Solo Construction Corporation has complied with the Settlement Agreement and all Department of Small Business Development enforcement actions on this project have been resolved.

The bid was reviewed by Seaport staff and the bidder was found to be responsive to all bid requirements. Also, the bids were reviewed by CH2M Hill, the Engineer of Record, and it was determined that the low bid was fair and reasonable. Solo Construction Corporation's principal has indicated 15+ years experience as a general contractor in construction work similar to the work for this contract. No evaluations were found for this company in the Capital Improvements Information System, but references listed in the Contractor's bid package were contacted and provided a satisfactory review for both the company and their experience. Therefore, the Seaport Department recommends this contract be awarded to Solo Construction Corporation.

BACKGROUND

On April 2, 1999, the Miami-Dade County Department of Environmental Resources Management ("DERM") issued a Notice of Violation to the Miami-Dade County Seaport Department and other parties for approximately three (3) acres of unauthorized dredging along the southern boundary of the Central Turning Basin in the South Channel, Port of Miami. On April 27, 1999, the Florida Department of Environmental Protection ("FDEP") issued a Warning Letter to the Miami-Dade County Seaport Department for the same unauthorized activity.

Subsequent assessment of the violation area determined that the County's dredging contractor, Dutra Construction Co., Inc. ("Dutra"), impacted approximately 3.5 acres of low to moderate density sea grasses outside of the permitted dredging area. This violation likely occurred between May 1995 and August 1996. Although the Port's dredging contractor committed the violation, under applicable environmental law, the County (through the Seaport Department), as the permittee and project owner or operator, had joint and several liability for the contractor's permit violations. As the County deemed Dutra's permit violations to constitute one of several breaches of contract covered by Dutra's performance bond (issued by surety Safeco Insurance Co.), the County brought a civil action against Safeco to recover under the performance bond. Among the damages, the County sought to recover from Safeco were the to-be-incurred mitigation and other costs arising from Dutra's permit violations. After 2 1/2 weeks of trial, Safeco settled by agreeing to pay the County 22.5 million and waiving all of its counterclaims against the County.

Since notice of the violations, the Seaport Department has worked closely with the FDEP and DERM to develop a mitigation plan acceptable by all parties. On April 9, 2002, the Board of County Commissioners passed Resolution R-367-02, authorizing the execution of a Consent Order between the State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection and Miami-Dade County for settlement of Miami Harbor dredging permit violations.

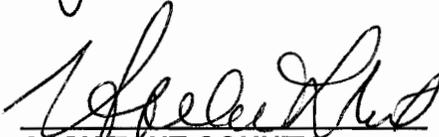

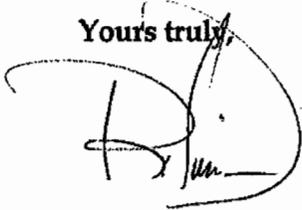
