Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) approve the attached resolution authorizing a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the City of Sweetwater and Miami-Dade County in which the County will purchase and deliver trees for planting within the city limits for a cost not to exceed \$20,000, and facilitate the training of Tree Care Specialists through the Institute of Food and Agricultural Sciences Extension (IFAS).

Scope

This agreement impacts the City of Sweetwater which is entirely located within Commission District 12.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

The project cost will not exceed \$20,000 and will be funded by Miami-Dade County through the Community Image Advisory Board (CIAB). This project will be funded by the CIAB Capital Outlay Reserve (COR) fund.

Background

Miami-Dade County has had historical losses in tree canopy cover due to hurricanes, citrus canker and urban development. In order to address such losses the Street Tree Master Plan (STMP) was developed by a working group comprised of representatives from various organizations. Said plan addresses the need to increase tree canopy along our roadways and serves as a reference for urban street tree projects. The STMP also describes the procedures for planting and maintaining trees throughout Miami-Dade County and encourages partnerships with municipalities for the implementation of the plan.

The City of Sweetwater has an ongoing effort to improve the aesthetics of their community and was of one of the first cities to approach the CIAB regarding the adoption of the STMP with their commitment of increasing the tree canopy. The CIAB unanimously agreed to assist the City with this project and directed the Office of Community Image to establish a partnership between the City and the County to accomplish this effort. As a result, the attached MOA stipulates that the CIAB will purchase and deliver trees up to a value of \$20,000 for planting in parks, medians, and public rights-of-way within the City limits.

The City of Sweetwater has agreed to plant and assume maintenance for these trees utilizing the best tree care standard practices. It is anticipated that the project will be completed by February 28, 2009.

The City of Sweetwater approved an earlier version of the attached MOA City Resolution No. 3283 that was revised by the County to include a clarification that the City of Sweetwater would be responsible for planting the trees and also revised the project completion date to February 28, 2009 from October 31, 2008. The City of Sweetwater will be amending the MOA and presenting it to their City Council on September 8, 2008.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY AND THE CITY OF SWEETWATER FOR THE PURCHASE AND DELIVERY OF TREES (NOT TO EXCEED \$20,000 FROM THE COMMUNITY IMAGE ADVISORY BOARD), TREE PLANTING WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS AND TRAINING OF CITY TREE CARE SPECIALISTS

WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County (County) and the City of Sweetwater (City) wish to restore recent tree losses due to hurricanes, citrus canker, and urban development; and

WHEREAS, the County, through the Community Image Advisory Board (CIAB), has agreed to assist municipal governments and train their personnel in best practices for tree planting and maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the County is willing to purchase and deliver trees (up to a value of \$20,000) for planting in parks, medians and public rights-of-way within the City limits; and

WHEREAS, the City will plant and maintain the trees planted in accordance with the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) using the best tree care standard practices set by one of the organizations that certify arborists,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board authorizes the Mayor or his designee to execute the MOA between the City of Sweetwater and Miami-Dade County for the purchase and delivery of trees (not to exceed \$20,000 provided by the CIAB), tree planting in the parks, medians and public rights-of-way within the city limits, and training of the City's tree care specialists.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner **Joe A. Martinez** who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Dennis C. Moss** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the **CITY** and **COUNTY** are concerned that recent losses in tree cover due to hurricanes, citrus canker, and urban development have had a negative impact on the green infrastructure and its ability to mitigate pollution and enhance air and water quality, and

WHEREAS, the **COUNTY** through the Community Image Advisory Board (CIAB) Street Tree Master Plan (STMP) has committed to assisting municipal governments improve the percentage of canopy cover in their cities, and

WHEREAS, the **COUNTY** through the CIAB has agreed to assisting municipal governments train their personnel in best practices for tree planting and maintenance, and

WHEREAS, the **CITY** Commission has by proper resolution attached hereto as attachment "A" and by reference made a part thereof, authorized its City Manager/Mayor or his designee to enter into this **AGREEMENT**.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises and the covenants contained herein, the parties agree:

1. The **COUNTY** shall purchase and deliver trees (up to a value of \$20,000) for planting in parks, medians and public rights-of-way within the **CITY** limits, see exhibit A-1.
2. The **COUNTY** shall arrange for training **CITY** employees on best practices for tree care and arborist certification.
3. The **CITY** will plant and maintain the trees planted as part of this **AGREEMENT** using the best tree care standard practices set by one of the organizations that certify arborists.

4. The **CITY** shall identify and obtain all necessary permits, utility adjustments and right-of-way to perform the project tree plantings in accordance with applicable State, Federal, and local laws and ordinances, and shall not commence the work described in this **AGREEMENT** until all necessary permits have been obtained.
5. The **CITY** shall clear all utilities within the planting areas at least forty-eight (48) hours prior to any tree installation activities.
6. The **CITY** shall not allow trees to obstruct the view of the **COUNTY'S** Public Works or Florida Department of Transportation's roadway signs.
7. The **CITY** shall be responsible for the inspection of the tree installations, see exhibit A1. Plantings shall be completed prior to February 28, 2009.
8. The **CITY** commits to adopting the principles of Street Tree Master Plan by approving the **COUNTY'S** plan or preparing an original plan that complements the concepts presented in the **COUNTY'S** plan.
9. To the extent permitted by law, the **CITY** shall indemnify and hold harmless the **COUNTY** its officers and employees, from all suits, actions, claims of liability arising out of the **CITY'S** negligent performance of the work under this **AGREEMENT**, due to the failure of the **CITY** to construct and maintain the tree plantings in conformance with the standards described in this **AGREEMENT**.


SECTION 1. That the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents required to accomplish receipt of the foregoing funding for trees purchase.





EXHIBIT A-1

Project Locations: City of Sweetwater

SW 115th Avenue from Flagler to 8th Street
SW 109th Avenue from Flagler to 8th Street
Linear Park north of 8th Street from SW 107th Avenue to 115th Avenue

Design: Miami-Dade County will prepare landscape plans depicting proposed planting location, installation details and notes; as well as, a plant list showing species, quantity, specifications, etc. Development of these plans will be coordinated with the City of Sweetwater.

Estimated Design Timeframe: 30 calendar days

Permitting: The project locations are along city roads. The City of Sweetwater will process any necessary plans and permit applications.

Estimated Permitting Timeframe: 30 calendar days

Construction: The Miami-Dade County Office of Community Image has agreed to design, select, and procure plant material for the implementation of the landscape enhancements. Based on the permit requirements, the City will be required to coordinate with utility companies, governmental agencies having jurisdiction and calling for inspections as required. The City will accept plant material and account for quantities, quality and size as specified on landscape plans provided by the County. No substitutions of plant material shall be accepted unless mutually agreed upon by City and the County and documented in writing. The County will perform a final inspection once material is installed.

Estimated Construction Timeframe: 30 calendar days

Plant Selection: The medians will be planted with drought tolerant species to minimize water use. The plans will include species mutually agreeable to the City of Sweetwater and Miami-Dade County that minimize water use and maintenance costs, decrease the likelihood of theft, are suitable to the location(s) for sun/shade adaptability, continuity of design to adjacent areas, and provide vibrant colors wherever possible.

Cost: Miami-Dade County's contribution of the purchase and delivery of plants, and the initial planting soil and mulch shall not to exceed \$20,000.






