Subject: Grant Application for Miami Metrozoo Flooded Forest Exhibit at Amazon and Beyond

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board approve the attached resolution authorizing the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to apply for a grant in the amount of \$478,000 from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) for construction of the interpretive elements of the Miami Metrozoo Flooded Forest Exhibit at Amazon and Beyond.

Scope

Miami Metrozoo is located at 12400 S.W. 152 Street in Commission District 9. The zoo is open to all residents and visitors of Miami-Dade County and has a countywide impact.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

This grant will contribute \$478,000 toward the \$613,000 cost of the interpretive elements of the Flooded Forest Exhibit. The remainder of the funds (\$135,000) will come from the Building Better Communities Bond Program.

Track Record/Monitor

FDEP has awarded the Park and Recreation Department (MDPR) grants in the past; however, this one is unique in that it implements an already awarded State of Florida legislative appropriation. This grant will be administered by Joyce Denny, MDPR Grants Administrator.

Background

FDEP's grant programs provide competitive grants to local governments to acquire and develop land for public outdoor recreation. This item provides for submission of a post award grant application which requires a Board approved resolution. The request for the appropriation was initiated by the Zoological Society of South Florida; however, the grant must be a contract between MDPR and the State, since MDPR is the owner of the property.

MDPR staff learned of the appropriation on Tuesday, August 26, 2008. The grant agreement is needed as soon as possible because work on the project is already well in progress and the grant will only pay for work completed after its execution.

RESOLUTION APPROVING SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION FOR \$478,000 IN GRANT FUNDS FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION, FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE INTERPRETIVE ELEMENTS OF THE MIAMI METROZOO FLOODED FOREST EXHIBIT AT AMAZON AND BEYOND AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO ACCEPT, EXPEND FUNDS, AND EXECUTE CONTRACTS AND AMENDMENTS AS REQUIRED

WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purpose outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board authorizes submission of a grant application in the amount of \$478,000 to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection for construction of the interpretive elements of the Miami Metrozoo Flooded Forest Exhibit at Amazon and Beyond; and further authorizes the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to execute such contracts and amendments as are required by this governmental body following approval by the County Attorney's Office; to receive and expend all monies for the purposes described in the funding request; and file and execute any necessary amendments to the agreement for and on behalf of Miami-Dade County, Florida.
