**Subject:** Contract Award Recommendation for Southwest Wellfield Removal of Calcium Carbonate Deposit from the North Lagoon - Project No: N/A; Contract No: W-907 in the amount of \$9,273,786.00 to Metro Equipment Service, Inc.

**RECOMMENDATION**

This recommendation for award for construction Contract No. W-907 between Metro Equipment Service, Inc., and Miami-Dade County in the amount of \$9,273,786.00 has been prepared by the Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department (WASD) and it is recommended for approval. At the present time, the existing lagoon at the Southwest Wellfield, which has been in service for over 30 years, is reaching full capacity. This project will provide WASD adequate storage capacity for the calcium carbonate residuals of the water treatment process at the Alexander Orr Jr. Water Treatment Plant (AOWTP).

**DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY**

The authority of the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to execute and implement this contract is consistent with those authorities granted under the Code of Miami-Dade County.

**SCOPE**

**PROJECT NAME:** Southwest Wellfield Removal of Calcium Carbonate Deposit from the North Lagoon

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The project consists of furnishing all labor, materials and equipment necessary to excavate, haul and legally dispose of the calcium carbonate residuals deposited from one of the lagoons at the Southwest Wellfield. The calcium carbonate is the material removed from the basins during the water softening process. The material is inert and non-toxic, and in its dry stage it is a very fine powder.

The scope of work includes, but it is not limited to the following: clearing, grubbing, excavating, loading into trucks with watertight bodies and covers, and hauling away approximately 573,000 cubic yards of calcium carbonate, and legally disposing of the material at an approved off-site location provided by the contractor; performing street cleaning along the calcium carbonate haul route; furnishing all labor, materials and equipment necessary to breach the existing dike, and reconstructing it with new limerock material upon completion of the work; furnishing and installing limerock fill as required; constructing a portable truck tire

wash station to be used during the duration of the project, and turned over to WASD at the completion of the project; electrical work; mechanical work; survey work; furnishing traffic control; and all other miscellaneous and appurtenant work for a complete project.

It is WASD's intent to obtain a complete, functional, and satisfactory installation under this project, and any items of labor, equipment or materials which may be reasonably assumed as necessary to accomplish this end shall be supplied whether or not they are specifically shown on the plans or stated in the specifications. The contractor shall provide all sheeting, shoring, bracing and all other labor, material or equipment required to preclude damage to, or loss of functionality of, any existing facility or system.

**SBD HISTORY OF VIOLATIONS:** Yes- Report Attached

Metro Equipment Service, Inc. appears in the report with one closed and one open violation for failure to meet CSBE subcontractor goals, for a total amount of \$440,372.40 (Originally \$707,812.40). The company has completed \$559,713 of its make-up plan submitted to the Department of Small Business Development (SBD), leaving a balance of \$148,099.40. This remaining balance has been approved by SBD to be completed in another WASD project.

**EXPLANATION:** WASD received eight bids for this project, and seven of the bids were under the Engineer's estimate. The low bidder is 43.26 percent under the original Engineer's estimate and 39.66 percent under the revised Engineer's estimate. The difference between the three lowest bidders is only 4 percent, showing good competition.

The cost estimate for this project was based in part on previous prices received for a similar project, Contract W-836: Alexander Orr Jr. Water Treatment Plant Removal of Calcium Carbonate Deposit, which was bid in 2007, with a Notice to Proceed date of May 5, 2008. Due to the volatile construction market conditions, WASD is experiencing an increased number of bidders and lower bid prices than estimated by the Engineer.

The Engineer has reviewed the unit prices submitted by Metro Equipment Service and determined that the bid is reasonable. Detailed analysis (Gap Analysis) is attached. Therefore, award of this contract to the low responsive and responsible bidder, Metro Equipment Service, Inc., is recommended.

Metro Equipment Service, Inc. shows 21 contracts from Miami-Dade County and 15 evaluations in the Office of Capital Improvements CIIS database, with an average rating of 3.4 out of a possible 4 points, a better than satisfactory performance by this vendor.

TO ALL BIDDERS:

In accordance with Section 3 of the INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS of Contract No. W-907, the documents for the above referenced project are hereby amended as follows:

1. To the ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS, first page, seventh paragraph, make the following changes:
  - A. On the first line, delete the value of the construction estimate which reads "\$14,890,000" and substitute therefore with the value "**\$14,000,000**". The quantity of calcium carbonate residual was recalculated for excavation to an average lagoon bottom elevation of +4.0 instead of 0.0 shown on the Plans.
  - B. On the second line, delete where the construction time reads "1460 consecutive calendar days" and replace with "**913 Consecutive Calendar Days**".
2. For the Contractor's information, survey cross sections taken after the lagoon was last emptied in 1982 are included as an attachment in this Addendum. The same baseline on the Plans was used in the 1982 cross section, however the lagoon was breached at a different location. Elevations on the cross section indicate that the natural ground is above the water table.
3. At the meeting it was incorrectly stated that the Department will provide water free of charge for the duration of the project. In accordance with Section 4.01 Water Used in Construction (modified herein), potable water and RAW water will be metered and charged for use. The Contractor may eliminate the 2" tap to the raw water line at the well house and only utilize potable water if he so chooses.
4. To the TABLE OF CONTENTS, Page 1 of 5, second line from the bottom of the Page listing the proposal pages, delete the word "1F" and replace with the word "**1G**".
5. To the PROPOSAL, delete Proposal in its entirety and substitute therefore the attached **Proposal** each page marked "**W-907 (Add. #4)**" in the lower left corner.

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Small Business Development (SBD) has completed a compliance review for the above-referenced project with the Community Small Business Enterprise (CSBE) Program. The contract measure applicable to this project is an 11% CSBE goal. The Construction Contracts Section of The Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department (WASD) submitted bid documents from Metro Equipment Service, Inc. for compliance review.

Metro Equipment Service, Inc. submitted the required Schedule of Intent (SOI) Affidavit committing to utilize NTP Site Development, a certified CSBE firm, to perform excavation contractor work at 15%. NTP Site Development signed the SOI Affidavit in agreement with the information listed. 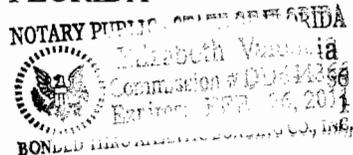

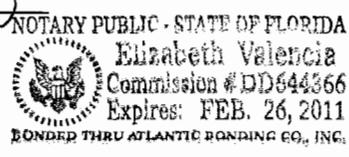
