

RECOMMENDATION

This recommendation to award construction Contract No. S-812 (A) to Poole & Kent Company of Florida by Miami-Dade County in the amount of \$18,096,498.00 has been prepared by the Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department (WASD) and is recommended for approval pursuant to Miami-Dade County Code, Section 2-8.2.11, Water and Sewer Department Contracting Authority.

This project is one in a series of projects under the High Level Disinfection (HLD) Program to comply with Consent Order No. 03-1376 negotiated by Miami-Dade County and the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP). It also adheres to regulatory requirements resulting from a rule change implemented by the US Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) to meet effluent quality standards for deep well disposal. Upon the completion of the entire project, the South District Wastewater Treatment Plant (SDWWTP) will be rated as a 285 million gallons per day (MGD) plant.

DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY

The authority of the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to execute and implement this contract is consistent with those authorities granted under the Code of Miami-Dade County.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The work consists of furnishing all materials, labor, and equipment necessary for the construction of five (5) new chlorine contact tanks (Contact Tanks No. 5 thru 9) at the SDWWTP.

The scope of work includes, but it is not limited to the following: demolition work and site preparation; excavation; loading, hauling and legally disposing of excess backfill; furnishing and installing approximately 205 linear feet (LF)

of 120-inch, 150 LF of 108-inch, 790 LF of 96-inch, 260 LF of 84-inch, 230 LF of 72-inch and 405 LF of 60-inch pre-stressed concrete cylinder pipe (PCCP) and fittings; furnishing and installing five (5) 72-inch x 72-inch, and five (5) 60-inch x 60-inch sluice gates with actuators; furnishing and installing five (5) 48-inch x 48-inch, and two (2) 48-inch x 72-inch slide gates; making a tapping connection to an existing 72-inch PCCP main; furnishing and installing ductile iron pipe, fittings, and valves; furnishing and installing pre-cast concrete structures; furnishing and installing free-chlorine analyzer systems; furnishing and installing magnetic flow meters and fire hydrants; constructing a drain lift station; constructing drain and flushing water installations; constructing a scrub water lift station, including making connections to an existing 24-inch scrub water main; constructing an electrical duct bank with a power manhole; furnishing and installing control panels, transformer, lighting, conduits, wiring and all other electrical items and work; testing and startup; mechanical work; and all other appurtenant and miscellaneous items.

It is WASD's intent to obtain a complete functional, and satisfactory installation under this project, and any items of labor, equipment or materials which may be reasonably assumed as necessary to accomplish this end shall be supplied whether or not they are specifically shown on the plans or stated in the specifications. The contractor shall provide all sheeting, shoring, bracing and all other labor, material or equipment required to preclude damage to, or loss of functionality of, any existing facility or system.

EXPLANATION: WASD received five bids for this project. One of the bidders did not use the revised proposal pages submitted in Addendum No. 4, and the bid was not considered. Three of the bids were under the Engineer's estimate. The low bidder is 6.78 percent under the Engineer's estimate. The difference between the three lowest bidders is only 5.58 percent demonstrating good competition. Therefore, WASD's recommendation is to award this contract to the low responsive and responsible bidder, Poole and Kent Company of Florida.

Poole and Kent Company of Florida was formed in 2004 to service the same geographic region that the southern division of The Poole and Kent Company used to serve. The personnel who operated the southern division of The Poole and Kent Company, which completed 16 County contracts for a total value of \$56,160,084.00 from March 1994 to March 2002, now operate Poole and Kent Company of Florida.

Within the last 10 months, Poole and Kent Company of Florida was awarded its first contracts with Miami-Dade County. As such, a review of the Office of Capital Improvements CIIS database revealed no contractor evaluations.

Small Business Development (SBD) has completed a compliance review for the above-referenced project with the Community Small Business Enterprise (CSBE) Program. The contract measure applicable to this project is a 10% CSBE goal. The Construction Contracts Section of The Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department (WASD) submitted bid documents from Poole and Kent Company of Florida (Poole and Kent) for compliance review.

Poole and Kent submitted the required Schedule of Intent (SOI) Affidavits committing to utilize Dodec, Inc. a certified CSBE firm, to furnish and install mechanical work at 7% and O.R. Dean Construction, Inc., a certified CSBE firm, to install reinforcement steel in concrete and placement of concrete at 3%. Each subcontractor signed its respective SOI Affidavit in agreement with the information listed. Poole and Kent fulfilled the contract measure requirement in agreement with the information listed. As such, Poole and Kent has fulfilled the contract measure requirement and is in compliance with the CSBE Participation Provisions.

SBD staff only reviewed and addressed compliance with the CSBE program and the established contract measure. The Construction Contracts Section of The Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department is responsible for any other issues that may exist.

THIS CONTRACT, made and entered into on the _____ day of _____, 20_____, by and between Miami-Dade County, Florida, acting by and through the Office of the Mayor, party of the first part (hereinafter sometimes called the "County"), and **Poole and Kent Company of Florida** _____, party of the second part (hereinafter sometimes called "Contractor");

WITNESSETH

That the parties hereto, for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter set forth, mutually agree as follows, to wit:

1. That the Contractor shall furnish all labor, materials and equipment and perform all work in the manner and form provided by the Contract Documents covering the Project of the County known and identified as

for the aggregate amount reflected by the Proposal, said aggregate amount being **Eighteen Million Ninety Six Thousand Four Hundred Ninety Eight Dollars and Zero Cents (U.S. Dollars) \$18,096,498.00.**

2. That the Contractor shall begin the work to be performed under this Contract on a day to be specified in a written order issued by the Engineer, and shall fully complete all work hereunder within the time or times stated in the Proposal.

3. 5. Any change orders or amendments shall not exceed \$500,000 in cumulative dollar amount and shall not exceed 15 percent of the contract price in cumulative percentage amount; provided however, that the foregoing limitation shall not apply to any change order or amendment related to environmental remediation or health requirements and the foregoing change orders and amendments shall require ratification by the Board; provided further that the County Mayor or his designee may reduce in any amount the scope and compensation payable under this contract and grant compensable and non-compensable time extensions thereunder.
