RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board approve the application of Patient Transportation Services, Inc. d/b/a P.T.S., Inc. for one Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate one combination wheelchair and stretcher vehicle.

SCOPE

This Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity is countywide, allowing the certificate holder to operate in unincorporated and incorporated areas of Miami-Dade County.

FISCAL IMPACT/FUNDING SOURCE

There is no fiscal impact to the County.

TRACK RECORD/MONITOR

Applicant is an existing permit holder with one Passenger Motor Carrier Certificate and three Non-emergency Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity. There is no enforcement history. The Consumer Services Department (CSD) will be responsible for monitoring this company.

BACKGROUND

On December 18, 1980, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Ordinance 80-145, later codified in Chapter 4, Article III of the Code of Miami-Dade County, providing for the regulation of non-emergency medical transportation. Section 4-44 of the County Code provides the procedures to be followed by the County in processing certificate applications. Based upon those requirements, the Board may issue or refuse to issue the certificate as applied for, or may issue the certificate with modifications or upon such terms and conditions as in its judgment the public interest may require. In reaching a determination, the Board shall consider the application, the County Manager's recommendation, all matters presented during the public hearing held at the November 12, 2008 Economic Development and Human Services Committee meeting, and among others the following criteria:

- (1) The ability of the applicant to provide the proposed service;
- (2) The adequacy of the management plan of the applicant; and
- (3) The benefits that will accrue to the public interest from the proposed service.

Each resolution approving an application shall specify that a certificate to operate a single non-emergency vehicle has been authorized thereby.

Patient Transportation Services, Inc. d/b/a P.T.S., Inc., located at 55 Ocean Lane Drive, Key Biscayne, Florida 33149, seeks to obtain a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide combination wheelchair and stretcher non-emergency medical transportation service to individuals

requiring this type of transportation. This is one of eight certificates requested by the applicant concurrently.

The applicant seeks to transport patients to and from various medical facilities throughout Miami-Dade County seven days a week, 24 hours a day. Non-emergency transportation rates are not regulated by Miami-Dade County; however, under the Code the Certificate Holder must file their rates with CSD and post them within the passenger compartment section of each vehicle. The proposed rates are listed on the attached rate schedule. The vehicle operated under this certificate will be required to meet the requirements of Section 4-49 of the Code establishing vehicle inspection frequencies.

The management plan submitted by Mr. Jorge Llanso, President of Patient Transportation Services, Inc. d/b/a P.T.S., Inc. includes maintenance, communication, and record keeping systems and meets the requirements of the Code. All required financial statements and credit references have been submitted. The proposed service standards meet all requirements of the Code and adequately meet transportation and comfort needs. A background investigation reveals no criminal record within the last five years for the officer(s) of the corporation.

The proposed services to be provided under this certificate will increase the availability of licensed non-emergency medical transportation in Miami-Dade County thus providing increased competition and high service standards to the public.
