

RESOLUTION NO. R-1377-08

RESOLUTION CREATING AN ILLEGAL DUMPING IN THE  
AGRICULTURAL AREA TASK FORCE

**WHEREAS**, illegal dumping in Miami-Dade County's agricultural area is a serious issue that merits immediate attention; and

**WHEREAS**, property owners in the agricultural area face an undue burden once illegal dumping occurs on the right-of-way adjacent to their farms, nurseries, groves and residences; and

**WHEREAS**, current policies addressing the issue of illegal dumping need to be reviewed by a task force comprised of impacted property owners and representatives from those County departments and agencies assigned to deal with this issue,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:**

Section 1. Miami-Dade County hereby establishes a Task Force on Illegal Dumping in the Agricultural Area (Task Force).

Section 2. The Task Force shall be comprised of one representative from the following organizations: Dade County Farm Bureau; Las Palmas; Dade FNGLA; Tropical Fruit Growers of South Florida; and Historic Redland Tropical Trail and one representative from the following offices: 311, Solid Waste, Police, Office of Neighborhood Compliance ,the Agricultural Manager and any other offices deemed appropriate by the County Manager/Mayor.

Section 3. The Task Force shall formulate recommendations to the Board of County Commissioners to deter illegal dumping in the agricultural area; to provide a cost-effective mechanism for the reporting and picking-up of refuse and debris; and to give property owners in the agricultural area the option of paying an annual fee for bulk solid waste pick up four times per year.

Section 4. The Task Force shall submit the Task Force's recommendations to the Board of County Commissioners not later than 120 days from the date of passage of this Resolution.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Dennis C. Moss. It was offered by Commissioner **Sally A. Heyman**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Carlos A. Gimenez** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
